The Texas Armed Services Scholarship was created to assist promising Texas students who are committed to education and service. It encourages young leaders to participate in the Texas Guard, Army National Guard, or Air National Guard, or to become commissioned officers in the United States armed services.

Selected students must meet two of the following four academic criteria:

- Be on track to graduate or graduated high school with the Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP) or the International Baccalaureate Program (IB).
- A high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Achieved a college readiness score on the SAT (1590) or ACT (23).
- Ranked in the top one-third of the prospective high school graduating class.

To receive the scholarship, a student must:

- Be appointed by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, State Senator or State Representative.
- Enroll in a Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC).
- Agree to:
 - Complete four years of ROTC training.
 - Graduate no later than six years after the date first enrolled.
 - After graduation, enter into:
 - A four year commitment to be a member of the Texas Army National Guard, Texas Air National Guard, Texas State Guard, United States Coast Guard, or United States Merchant Marine; or
 - Contract to serve as a commissioned officer in any branch of the armed services of the United States.
 - Repay the scholarship if the requirements are not met.
 - Meet the satisfactory academic progress requirements set by the institution.

Scholarships will be converted to loans for recipients who are unable to fulfill the terms of the written agreement.
