DRILLING BAN NEGATIVELY IMPACTS LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

The Barnett Shale generated \$5.3 billion in tax revenue funding for local governments between 2001-2011 (including \$730.6 million in 2011). Oil and natural gas tax revenues also generate billions of dollars in funding for essential STATE government services, infrastructure and education.

PROPERTY OWNER RIGHTS AT RISK

Landowner, homeowner and mineral owner rights are constitutionally protected from abusive government takings. If responsible drilling is banned in the city, property owner rights and income from these private assets will be wrongfully denied.

TAXPAYERS WILL BE FORCED TO FOOT EXPENSIVE LEGAL BILL

A ban on hydraulic fracturing in the City of Denton will lead to lengthy and expensive lawsuits with taxpayers footing the bill for the city's litigation costs. At risk will be millions of taxpayer dollars that could be better spent on citizen services, public safety and city infrastructure needs.
