Introduction

The Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) will direct the completion of a limited number of federally-funded Targeted Brownfields Site Assessments (TBAs) for sites or waste under RRC jurisdiction (oil & gas). The TBAs are similar to Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs) conducted by the real estate industry for commercial and industrial properties. The Texas Natural Resource Code Ann. Chapter 91.101 and 16 TAC Part 1, Chapter 3.30 provides information on oil & gas activities and RRC jurisdiction.

In addition to performing assessments, the RRC will provide regulatory guidance. Such guidance may include developing cleanup levels, cleanup options, and clarification of environmental regulatory requirements as applicable. Please refer to section 2 to determine eligibility.

How Will Sites be Chosen?

The RRC would like to provide TBAs for as many eligible sites as possible. However, in the event that the number of eligible sites nominated outnumber the available resources, sites will be prioritized based on the following criteria (order does not imply importance):

- 1. Site location Populated or environmentally sensitive areas
- 2. Site ownership If the site is owned by local government
- 3. Tax status of site Increased appraised value due to cleanup
- 4. Condition of site Ready for redevelopment
- 5. Contamination concerns Low to moderate contamination
- Leveraging- If other funding sources for redevelopment depend on this assessment
- 7. Redevelopment plan Timing of implementation and number of jobs created

10. Limitations of RRC Brownfields Site Assessments

The following limitations of the RRC TBA should be considered prior to completing a TBA Grant application:

- The TBA process is not appropriate to correct situations where an immediate and substantial endangerment to human health and the environment exists. For the assessment and remediation of such sites, the applicant is directed to immediately contact the nearest district office of the RRC.
- 2. The TBA process may not be appropriate for sites in which there are active and ongoing oil & gas activities.
- 3. The applicant should recognize that environmental site assessments cannot eliminate all uncertainty, are not always exhaustive in their level of inquiry, or warrant being exhaustive in their level of inquiry. Therefore, the RRC cannot be held liable for any damage arising from contamination not discovered during the RRC TBA or from any damages, monetary or otherwise, from contamination discovered during the RRC TBA.
- 4. The TBA process cannot address all of the safety hazards associated with a site.

11. Intent to Participate

Applicants should be aware that in order for the RRC to issue a VCP Certificate of Completion for an entire site as it is currently described in this application the applicant must provide an adequate metes and bounds description of the property.

The undersigned also affirms that the applicant is not a Responsible Person as defined in Section 91.113 (b) of the Texas Natural Resource Code. The Commission may also request additional information to support these affirmations.
