Well Plugging and Site Remediation Fiscal Year 2014, 4th Quarter Report

Well Plugging: The 4<sup>th</sup> quarter well plugging performance includes 231wells plugged with Oil and Gas Regulation and Cleanup (OGRC) funds. This includes wells for which the state-funded plug files have been formally closed in Austin. The fiscal year total is 563 wells plugged with OGRC funds. The number of wells physically plugged during FY 14, through the end of the 4th quarter, based on the daily field reports is 574 with a total expenditure of \$15,203,213. Additionally, during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 77 wells were approved for plugging with state funds for a fiscal year total of 623 wells. At the end of fiscal year 2014, 956 wells were approved and remain to be plugged. During FY 14 bids have been prepared on 853 wells, of which 574 have been plugged, contracts have been awarded for 119 wells, and bids remain to be opened on 160 wells. The well plugging goal for fiscal year 2014 is 529 wells. The actual wells plugged and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2012, 2013 and 2014 and the well plugging goals and budgets by district for fiscal year 2014 are shown on the attached graphs. The FY 14 budget for Well Plugging is \$15,888,259.

Site Remediation: During the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter Site Remediation completed and formally closed 121 cleanup activities, of which 116 were completed with the use of OGRC funds and 5 were completed using Grant funds. Additionally, during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 52 cleanup activities were authorized and at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter a total of 26 cleanup activities are authorized and remain to be completed. Site Remediation has completed and formally closed a total of 238 cleanup activities during the fiscal year, of which 231 were completed with the use of OGRC funds and 7 were completed using Grant funds. The actual remediation activities and expenditure by district for fiscal years 2012, 2013, and 2014 and the goals and budgets for the Site Remediation activities for fiscal year 2014 are shown on the attached graphs. Site Remediation's approved FY14 budget is \$3,125,725.53.

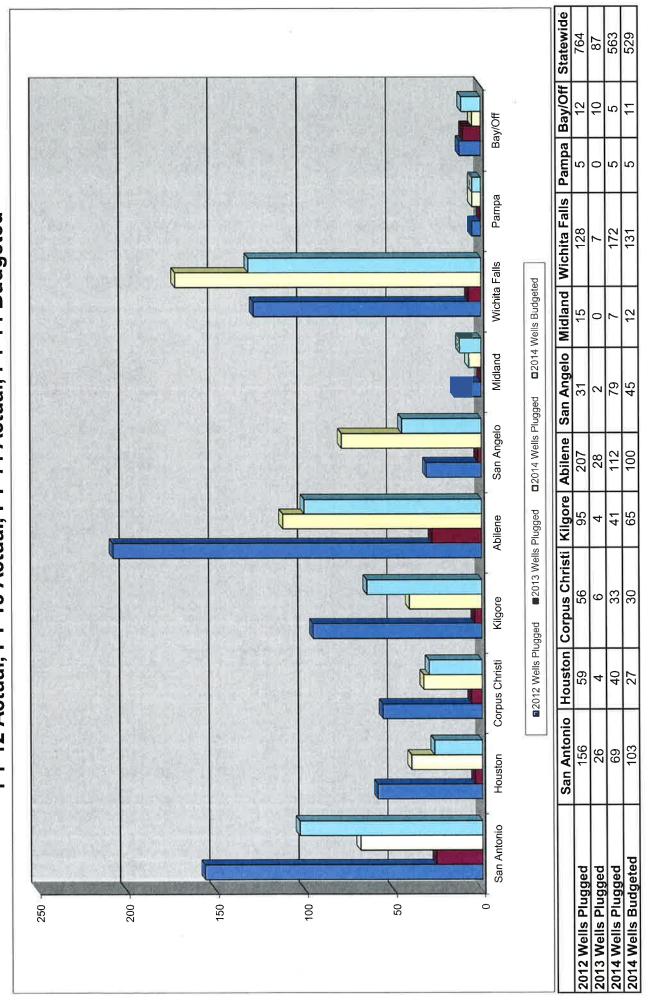

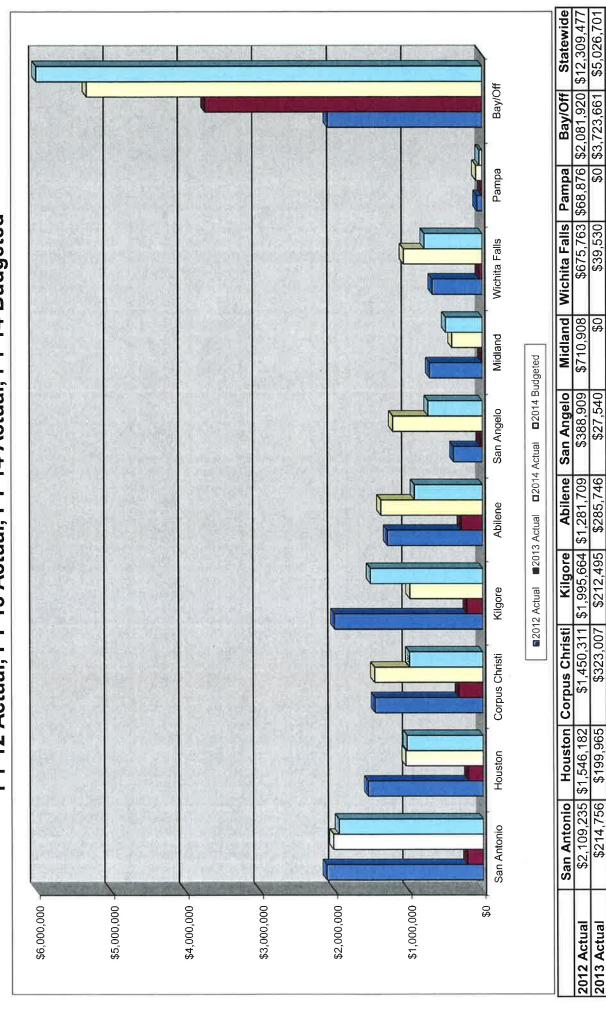
