

## Alaska

In Alaska, interviews with $\mathbf{1 , 0 1 5}$ adult Americans conducted by telephone by ORC International on October 1-6, 2014. The margin of sampling error for results based on the total sample is plus or minus 3 percentage points. The Alaska sample also includes 875 interviews among registered voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points) and 704 interviews among likely voters (plus or minus 3.5 percentage points). In Alaska, 713 interviews were conducted among landline respondents and 302 interviews among cell phone respondents.

## METHODOLOGY

In Alaska, a total of 1,015 adults were interviewed by telephone. All respondents were asked questions concerning basic demographics, and the entire sample was weighted to reflect statewide Census figures for gender, race, age, education and region of the state. Registered voters were asked questions about their likelihood of voting, past voting behavior, and interest in the campaign; based on the answers to those questions, 704 respondents were classified as likely voters. Among those likely voters, $14 \%$ described themselves as Democrats, $55 \%$ described themselves as Independents, and 31\% described themselves as Republicans.

In the Alaska crosstabs, the state regions are composed of the following counties: the "Anchorage" region is composed of Anchorage Municipality; the "Kenai/Mat-Su" region is composed of Kenai Peninsula Borough and Matanuska-Susitna Borough; the "Panhandle" region is composed of Haines Borough, Hoonah-Angoon Census Area, Juneau City and Borough, Ketchikan Gateway Borough, Petersburg Census Area, Prince of Wales-Hyder Census Area, Sitka City and Borough, Skagway Municipality and Wrangell City and Borough; the "Rest of State" region is composed of Aleutians East Borough, Aleutians West Census Area, Bethel Census Area, Bristol Bay Borough, Denali Borough, Dillingham Census Area, Fairbanks North Star Borough, Kodiak Island Borough, Lake And Peninsula Borough, Nome Census Area, North Slope Borough, Northwest Arctic Borough, Southeast Fairbanks Census Area, Valdez-Cordova Census Area, Wade Hampton Census Area, Yakutat City and Borough.

Crosstabs on the following pages only include results for subgroups with enough unweighted cases to produce a sampling error of $+/-8.5$ percentage points or less. Some subgroups represent too small a share of the population of Alaska to produce crosstabs with an acceptable sampling error. Interviews were conducted among these subgroups but results for groups with a sampling error larger than $+/-8.5$ percentage points are not displayed.
