

NGI Plans To Split Its Transco Zone 6, Non-New York Index Into Separate North & South Point Indexes Effective August 2014

Dear Subscribers,

In an effort to remain up-to-date with rapidly evolving market conditions, NGI plans to separate its existing Transco Zone 6, Non-NY index location into separate Transco Zone 6 Non-NY North and Transco Zone 6, Non-NY South indexes. We will retain the existing Transco Zone 6, Non-NY index, which will be a combination of the two separate North and South indexes.

These changes, which are summarized below, will go into effect beginning with the **August 2014** editions of NGI's *Daily Gas Price Index*, *NGI's Weekly Gas Price Index* and *NGI's Bidweek Survey* newsletters and datafeed services.

Northeast	Transco Zn 6 Non-NY North	New index	Includes all transactions within Transco Zone 6 north of Compressor Station 195 in York County, PA, with the exception of those areas specified in our Transco Zone 6 NY and Leidy Line indexes. Deals at Leidy, PA will also be excluded from this listing, as those are reflected in a separate index.	All
Northeast	Transco Zn 6 Non-NY South	New index	Contains all deals from the beginning of Transco Zone 6 at the Virginia/Maryland border to Station 195 in York County, PA.	All
