**RE: Open-Enrollment Charter Held by Honors Academy, Inc.**

Dear Mr. Dodd and Ms. Metzger:

This is to notify you that I, as Commissioner of Education, am revoking the open-enrollment contract for charter held by Honors Academy, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "charterholder") for the Honors Academy pursuant to Texas Education Code (TEC) §12.115(c) effective June 30, 2014.

I. The Open-Enrollment Charter

On or about July 23, 1998, one2one Texas Learning Foundation<sup>1</sup> submitted an application for approval of an open-enrollment charter school. Based on the statements, assurances, commitments, and representations made by one2one Texas Learning Foundation in its charter application and related documentation, the State Board of Education (SBOE) approved Honors Academy charter application. On or about December 2, 1998, Jack Christie, then-Chair of the SBOE, and Alastair Howie, Executive Director of one2one Texas Learning

Foundation, executed a charter contract creating the open-enrollment charter school that is the subject of this action.

The Charter Contract, granted under Subchapter D, Chapter 12 of the TEC, provides that the terms of the open-enrollment charter granted to oneZone Texas Learning Foundation by the SBOE to include:

(a) [the charter] contract; (b) applicable law; (c) Request for Application (RFA) #701-98-016; (d) any condition, amendment, modification, revision or other change to the charter adopted or ratified by the [SBOE]; (e) all statements, assurances, commitments and representations made by the Charterholder in its application for charter, attachments, or related documents, to the extent consistent with (a) through (d); and (f) assurance by Charterholder, evidenced by execution of this contract, that no false information was submitted to the Agency or the Board by Charterholder, its agents or employees in support of its application for charter.

The Charter Contract was issued for a term beginning December 2, 1998, through July 31, 2003, unless renewed or terminated. On or about, June 26, 2003, TEA received a renewal application from Honors Academy. The renewal application is currently pending.

## **II. Revocation under TEC §12.115(c)**

During the 83<sup>rd</sup> legislative session, TEC §12.115 was amended to include a statutory provision for the revocation of charters that fail to meet academic or financial accountability performance ratings for the three preceding school years, or any combination thereof. Charters failing to meet the specified criteria are subject to mandatory revocation of their charter. The specific school years that must be considered in reaching any revocation decision are also listed. TEC §12.115(c).

The commissioner shall revoke the charter of an open-enrollment charter school if: 1) the charter holder has been assigned an unacceptable performance rating under Subchapter C, Chapter 39, for the three preceding school years; 2) the charter holder has been assigned a financial accountability performance rating under Subchapter D, Chapter 39, indicating financial performance lower than satisfactory for the three preceding school years; or 3) the charter holder has been assigned any combination of the ratings described by Subdivision (1) or (2) for the three preceding school years.

For purposes of revocation under Subsection (c)(1), the initial three school years for which academic performance ratings under Subchapter C, Chapter 39, shall be considered are 2009-2010, 2010-2011, and 2012-2013. For purposes of revocation under Subsection (c)(2), financial performance ratings, the initial three school years for which financial accountability performance ratings under Subchapter D, Chapter 39, shall be considered are 2010-2011, 2011-2012, and 2012-2013. TEC §12.115(c-1).

Specifically, the Honors Academy was assigned the following ratings:

- 2009-2010 academic performance rating of "Academically Unacceptable" (Exhibit A);

- 2010-2011 academic performance rating of "Academically Unacceptable" (Exhibit B); and
- 2012-2013 academic performance rating of "Improvement Required" (Exhibit C).

All rights to appeal the ratings identified above have been waived or exhausted, and these ratings are now final and not appealable. Accordingly, pursuant to TEC §12.115(c), the charter held by Honors Academy, Inc. is subject to mandatory revocation.

### **III. Appointment of a Conservator**

Further, I am assigning a conservator, pursuant to TEC §39.102(a)(7) and 19 TAC §97.1073. I am appointing Karen Case to the Honors Academy to serve as a TEA conservator.

As a TEA conservator, Karen Case's role will include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Overseeing the financial management and governance of the charter school to ensure the charter school complies with state and federal law;
- Attending board meetings, including executive session, and directing the board as necessary to address the findings in the Final Report; and
- Overseeing all close-out activities of the charter school.

Please note that the appointment of Karen Case does not relieve the charter school and its board of trustees of the responsibility to, at all times, operate the district in compliance with all applicable statutes and rules. The agency reserves the right to implement all available interventions and sanctions under TEC, Chapters 39, and Title 19, TAC, Chapters 97, to address the current, or any future, deficiencies identified for Honors Academy.

Agency staff will be present at the next meeting of the board of trustees to introduce Karen Case to the members of the board. The cost of the conservator's services will be paid by the district in accordance with TEC §39.110. The conservator's fee shall be \$85 per hour plus necessary travel expenses not to exceed the state per diem rate. Failure to make timely payments to the conservator may result in appropriate amounts being deducted from the district's Foundation School Program (FSP) funds.

### **IV. Opportunity for Informal Review and Hearing**

This is your notice of my intent, as Commissioner of Education, to revoke the open-enrollment charter contract held by Honors Academy, Inc. effective June 30, 2014. You have the right to request an informal review of, and hearing regarding, my decision. However, this informal review and hearing shall be provided only if the charter holder submits a written request that contains specific answers to each of the findings included in this Notice not later than January 15, 2014. Failure to submit a request by January 15, 2014, shall result in waiver of any right to an informal review or hearing on the revocation of the open-enrollment charter.

If you submit a timely request and I do not change my decision during the informal review, this issue will be sent to the State Office of Administrative Hearings for a hearing pursuant to TEC §12.116. Any hearing provided shall be limited to the specific findings and

revocation detailed in this correspondence. Under TEC §12.116(c), the administrative law judge must uphold my decision unless the judge finds the decision is arbitrary and capricious or clearly erroneous. The decision of the administrative law judge is final and may not be appealed.

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
