WHEREAS the North Central Texas cities of Azle and Reno have experienced more than 30 minor earthquakes in December 2013 and January 2014;

WHEREAS the citizens from those areas met with representatives of the Railroad Commission of Texas to urge them to study the possible links between seismic activity and wastewater injection wells and to take necessary regulatory action,

WHEREAS the Railroad Commission of Texas has responded to the public outcry by proposing some rule changes regarding injection wells: to require historical seismic data on injection well applications in high-risk areas, and to allow the TRC to suspend or terminate a permit if seismic activity occurs near an injection well;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Neighborhoods of East Fort Worth supports the amendment proposed by the Railroad Commission of Texas of 16 Texas Administrative Code Section 3.9, relating to Disposal Wells, and Section 3.46, relating to Fluid Injection into Productive Reservoirs; Oil & Gas Docket No. 20-0290951.
