- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

3	(a) Limitation on Permit Requirement.—Sec-
4	tion 402 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33
5	U.S.C. 1342) is amended by striking subsection (l) and
6	inserting the following:
7	"(l) Limitation on Permit Requirement.—The
8	Administrator shall not require a permit under this section
9	for discharges composed entirely of return flows from irri-
10	gated agriculture, nor shall the Administrator directly or
11	indirectly, require any State to require such a permit.".

18	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Inte-
19	rior shall conduct a study of stormwater impacts

24	(A) an analysis of measurable contamina-
25	tion in such area;

1	(B) an analysis of ground water resources

3	(C) an analysis of the susceptibility of
4	aquifers in such area to contamination from

7	(2) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the
8	date of enactment of this section, the Secretary shall
9	submit to Congress a report on the results of studies
10	conducted under paragraph (1).
