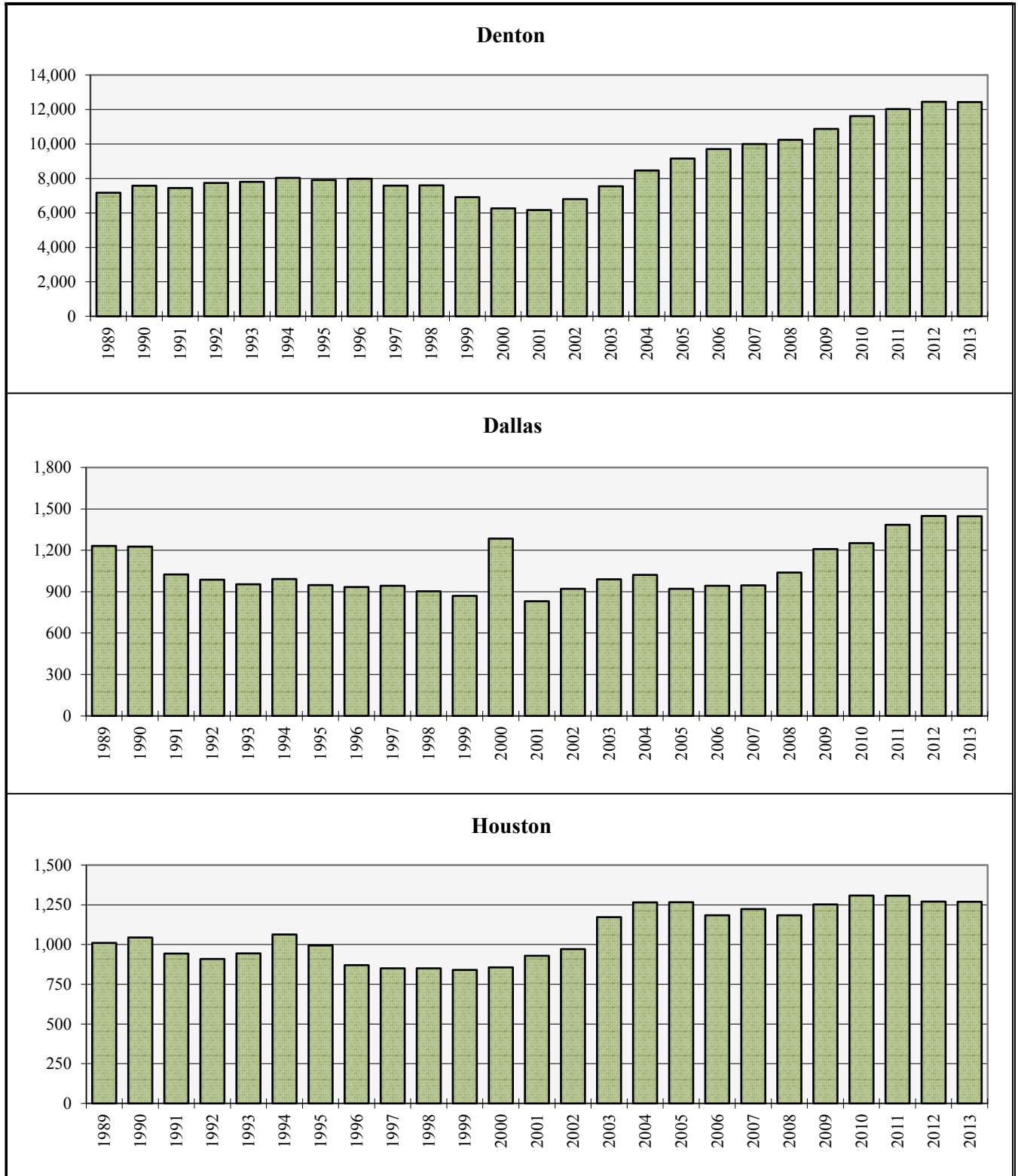

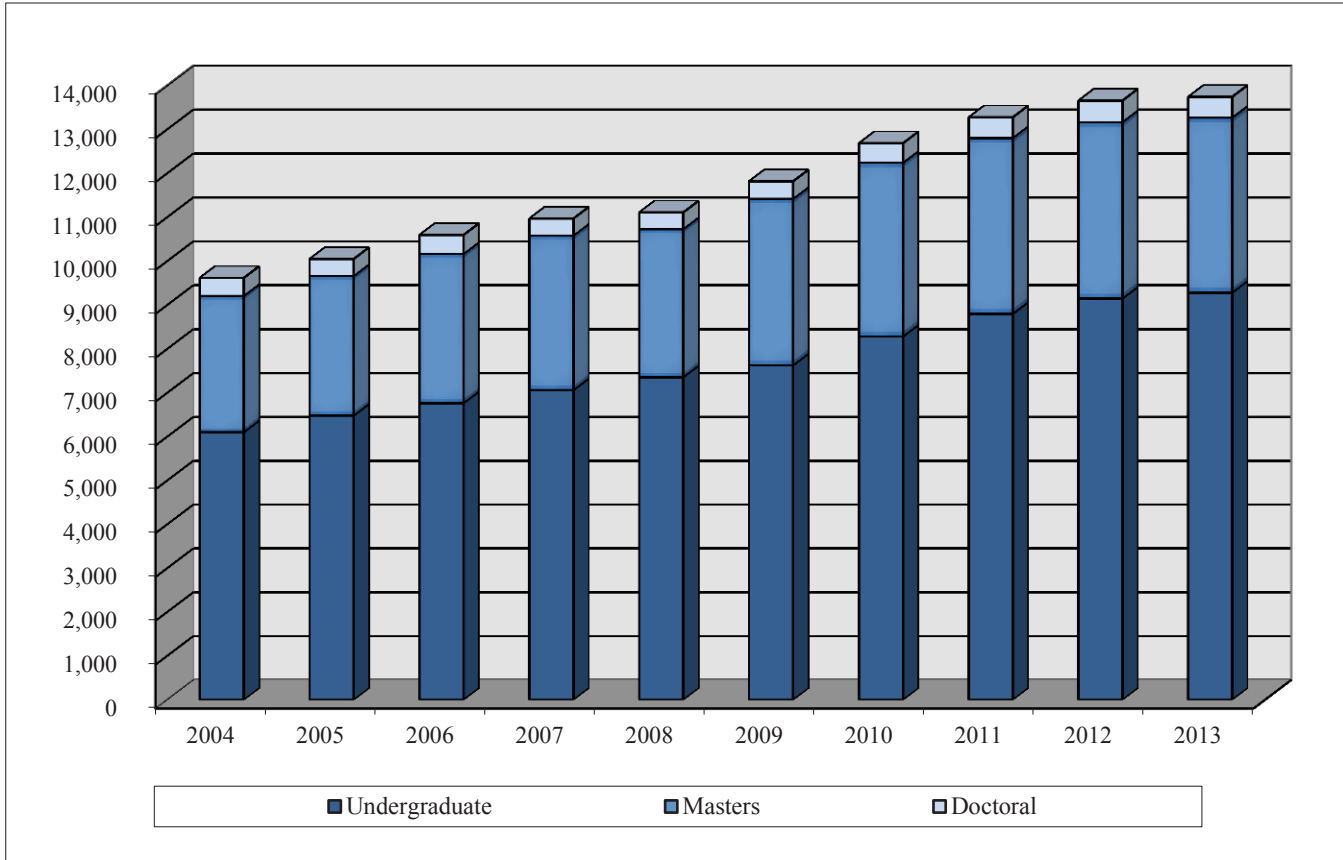

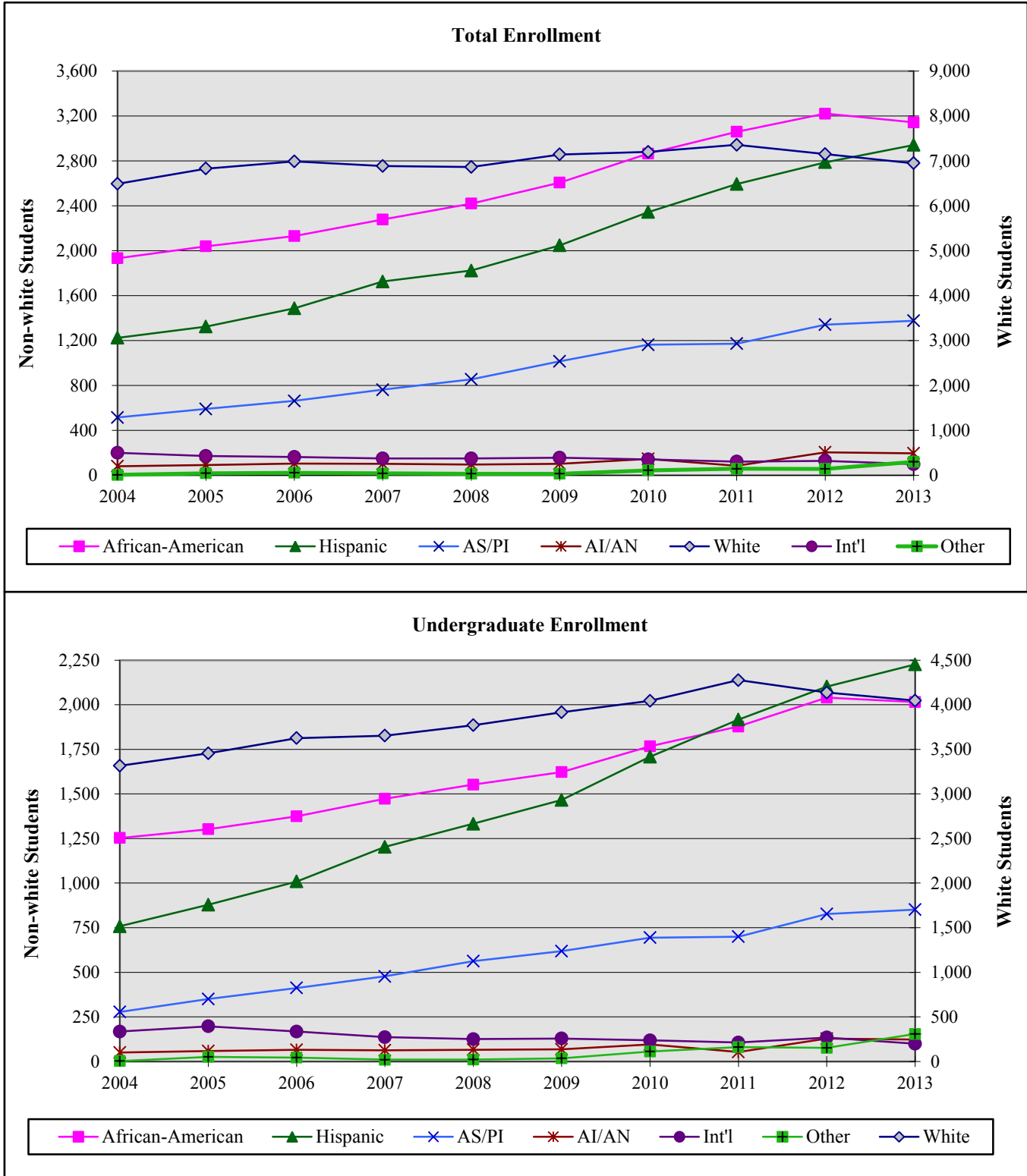

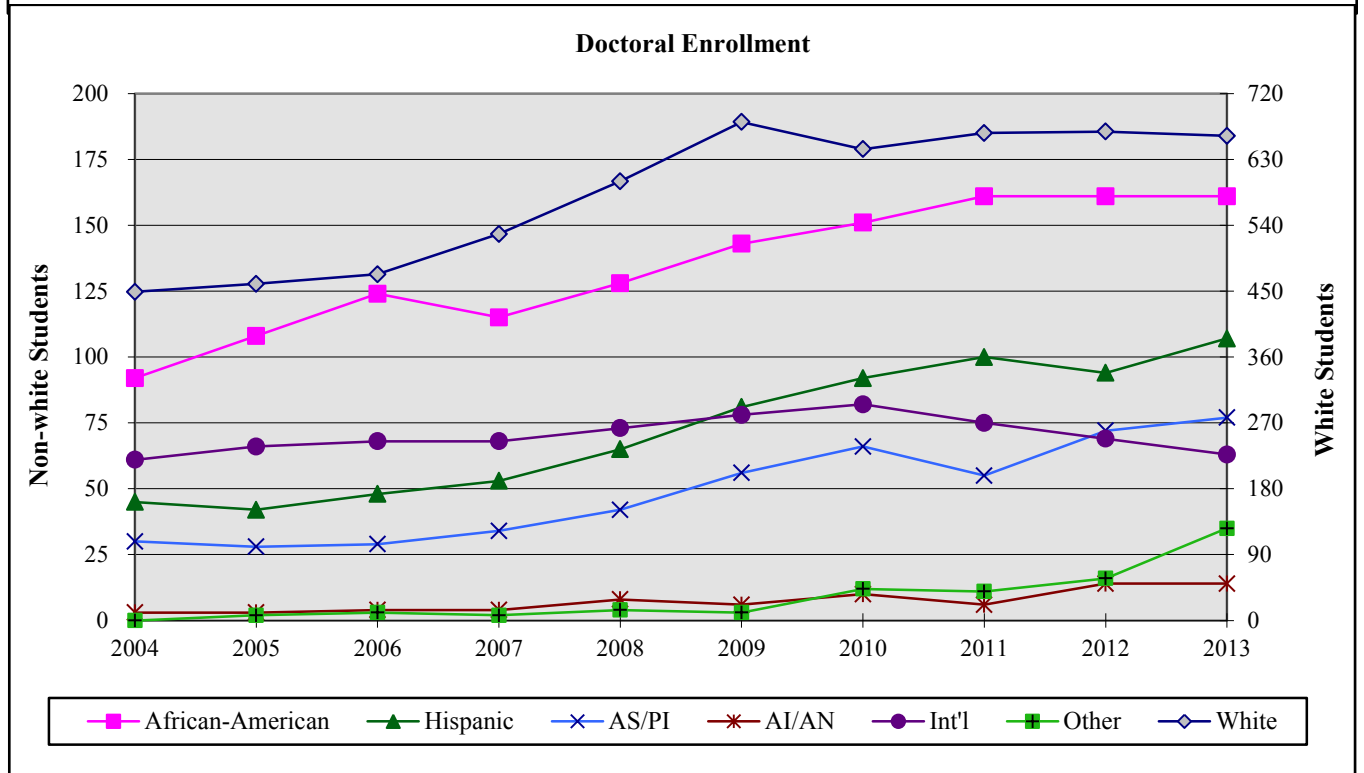
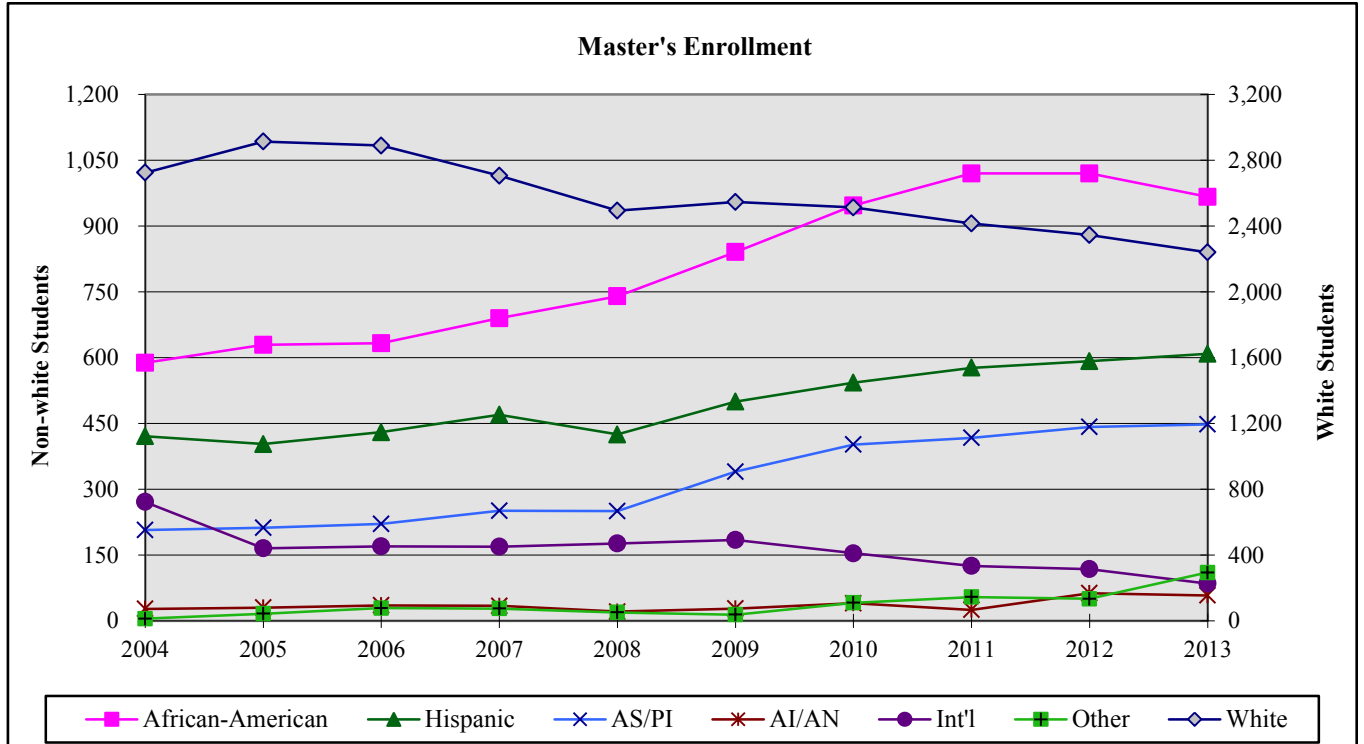

Fall Semesters, 2004 through 2013



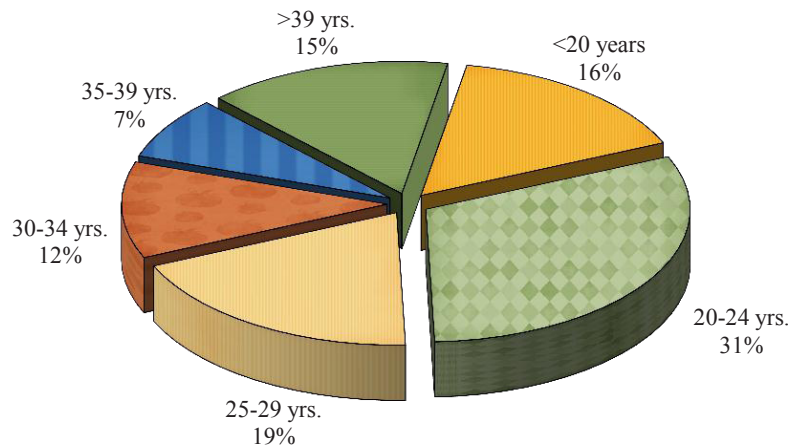

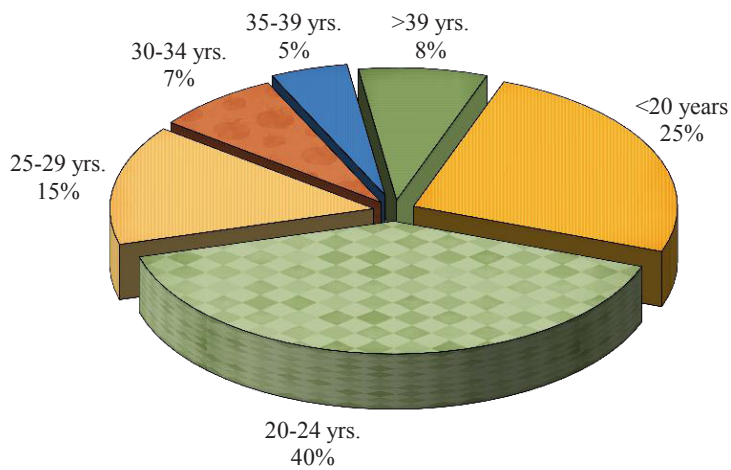

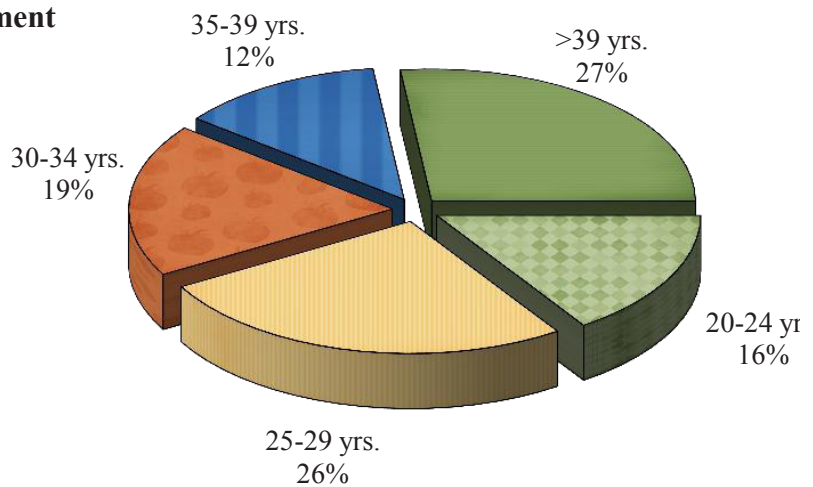
Age Distribution of Enrolled Students by Level Chart

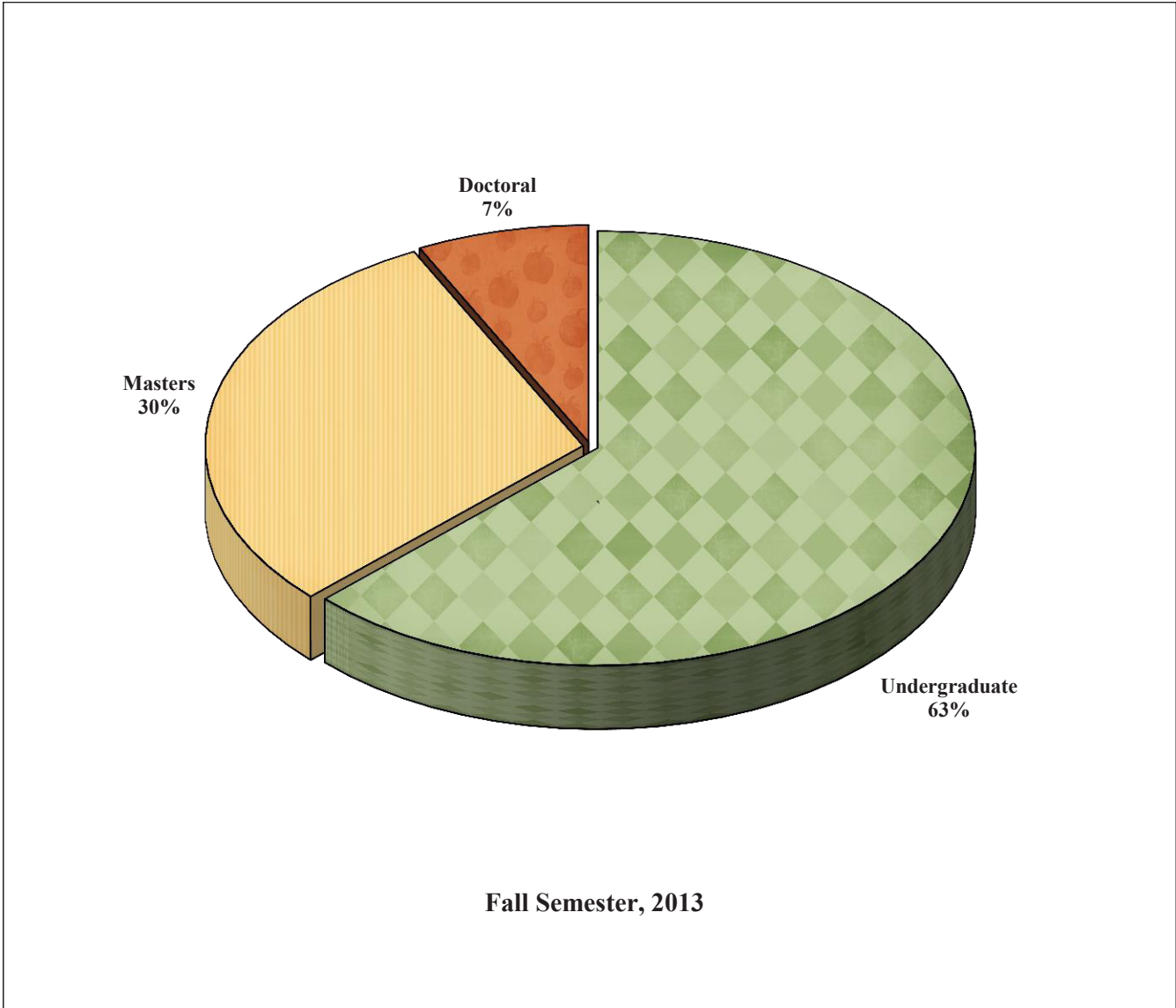

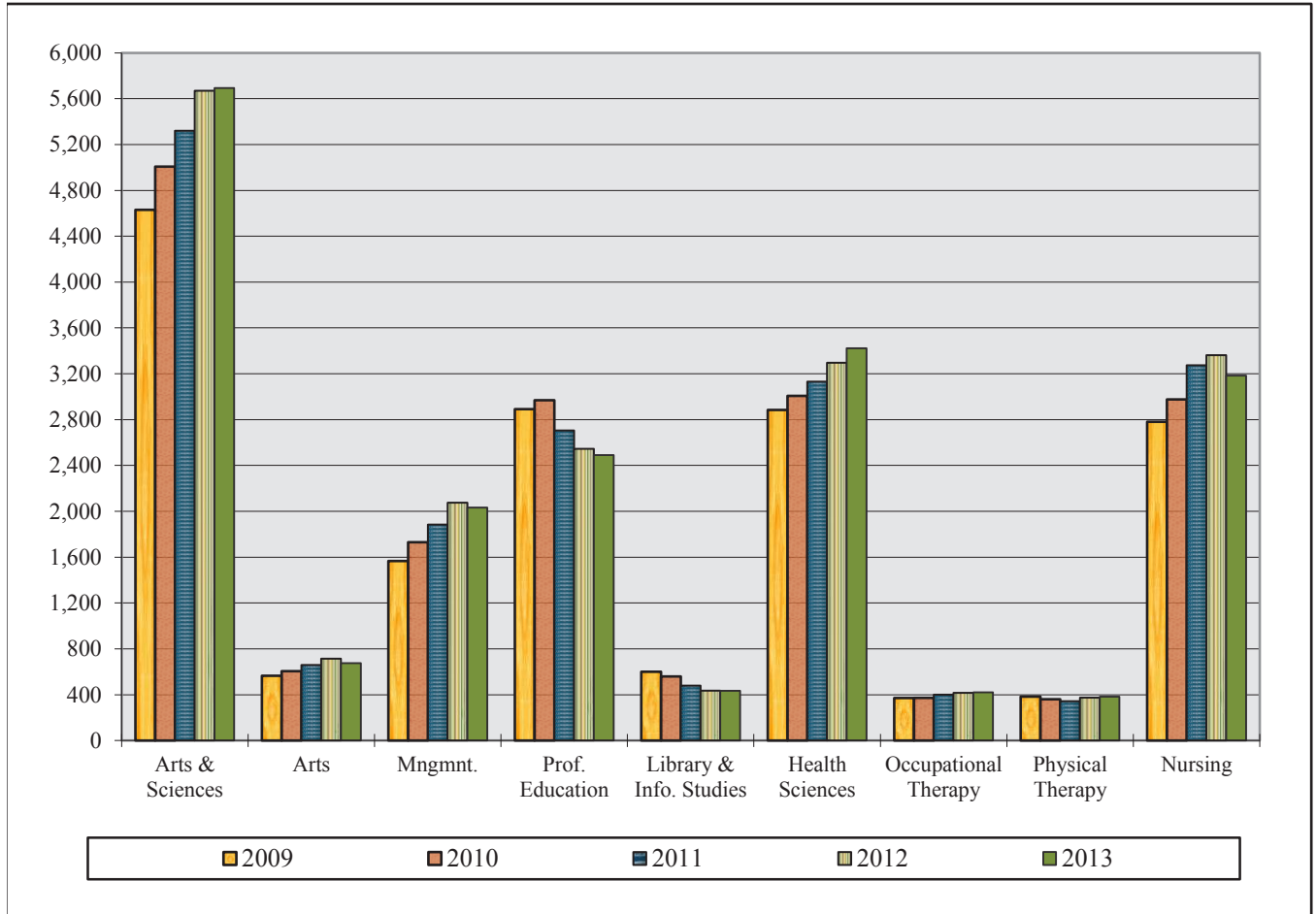

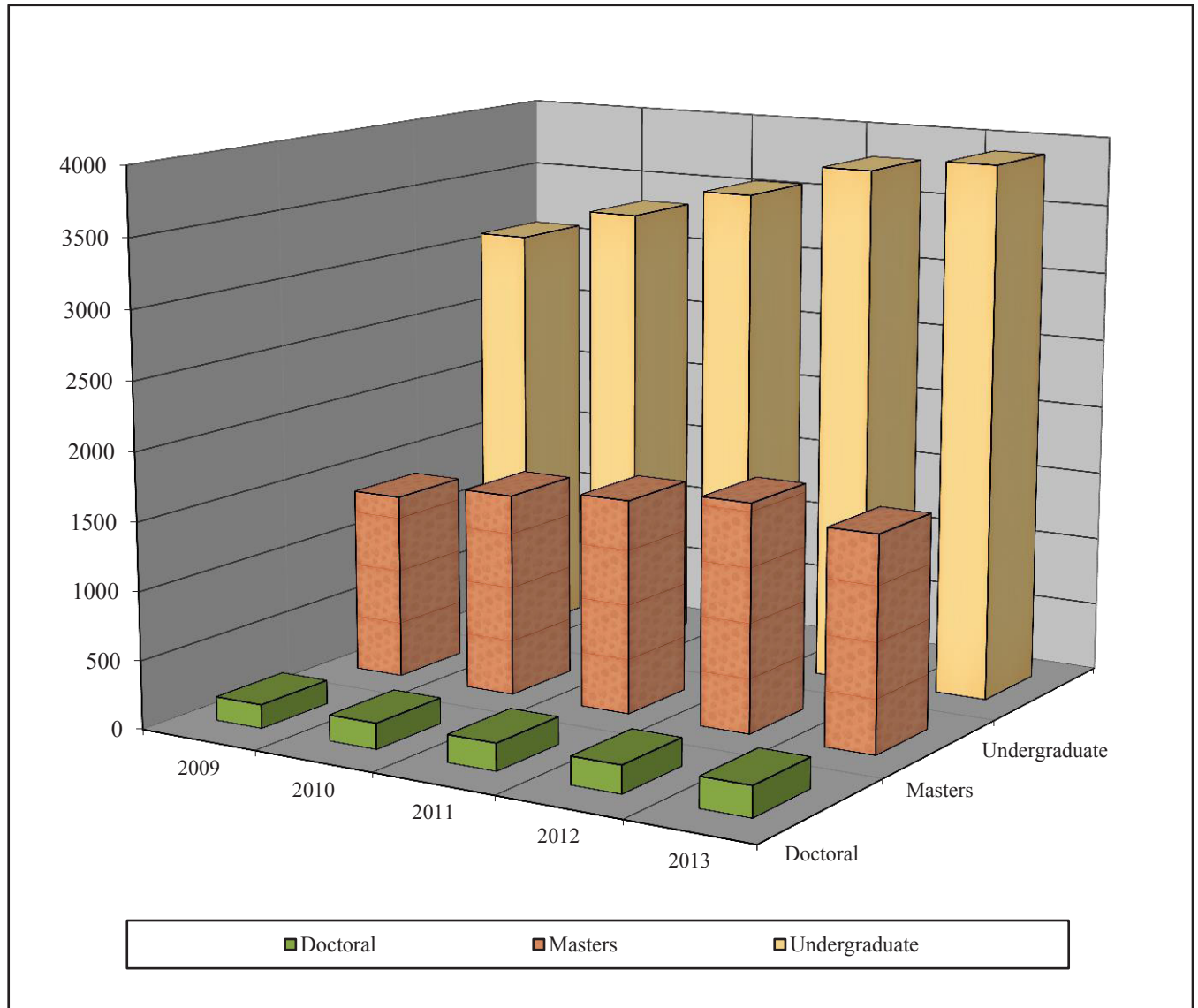

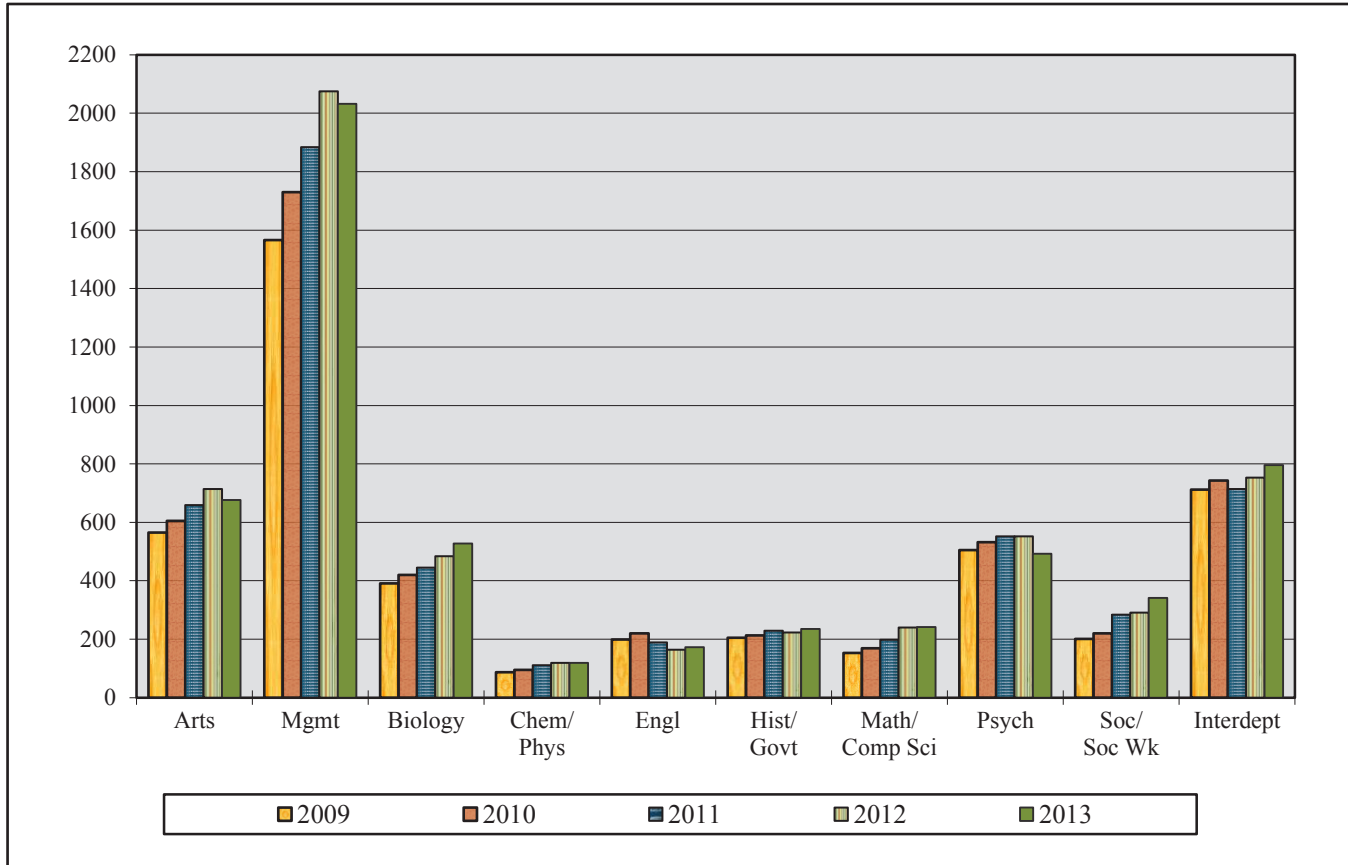

Fall Semesters, 2009 through 2013



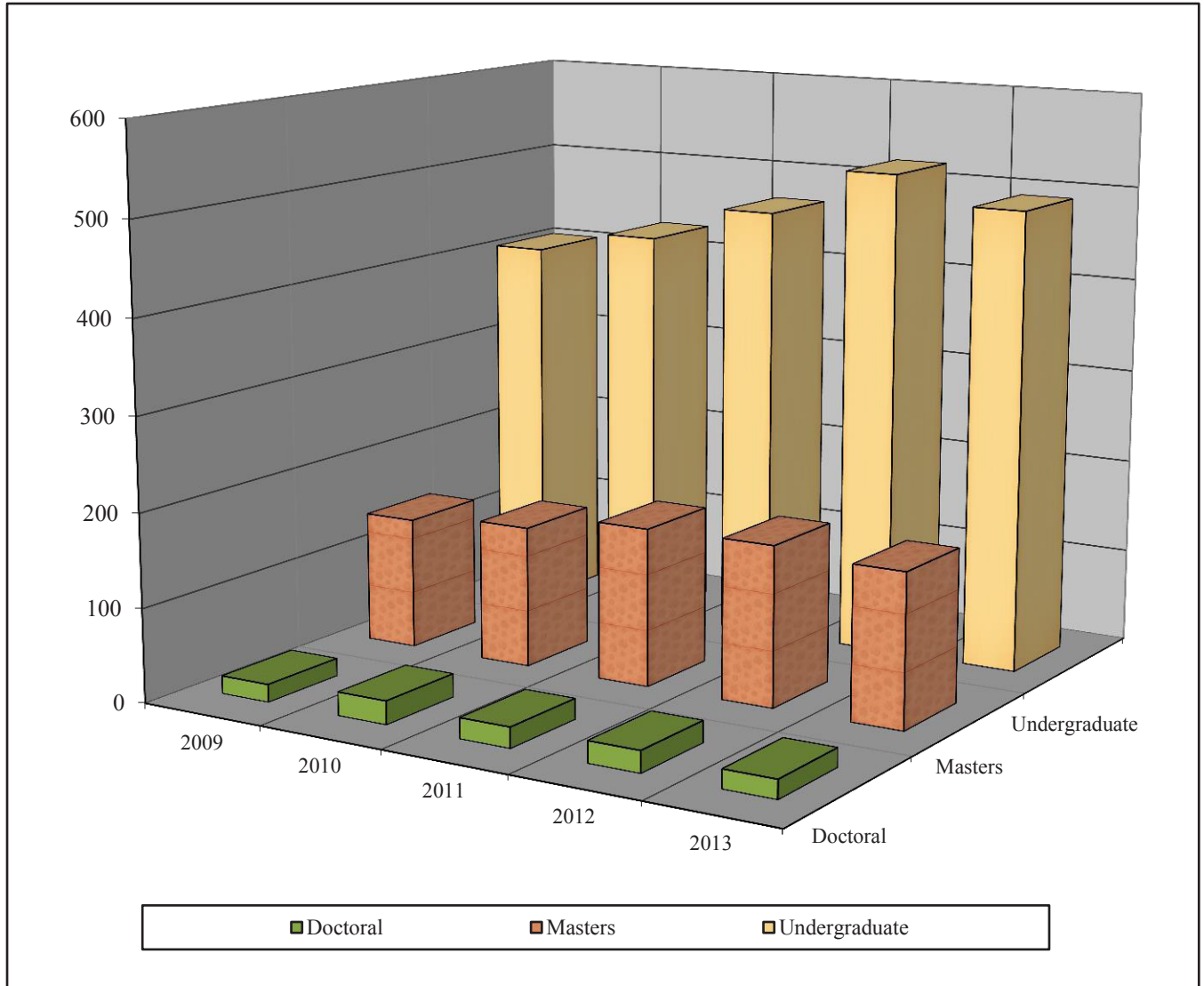

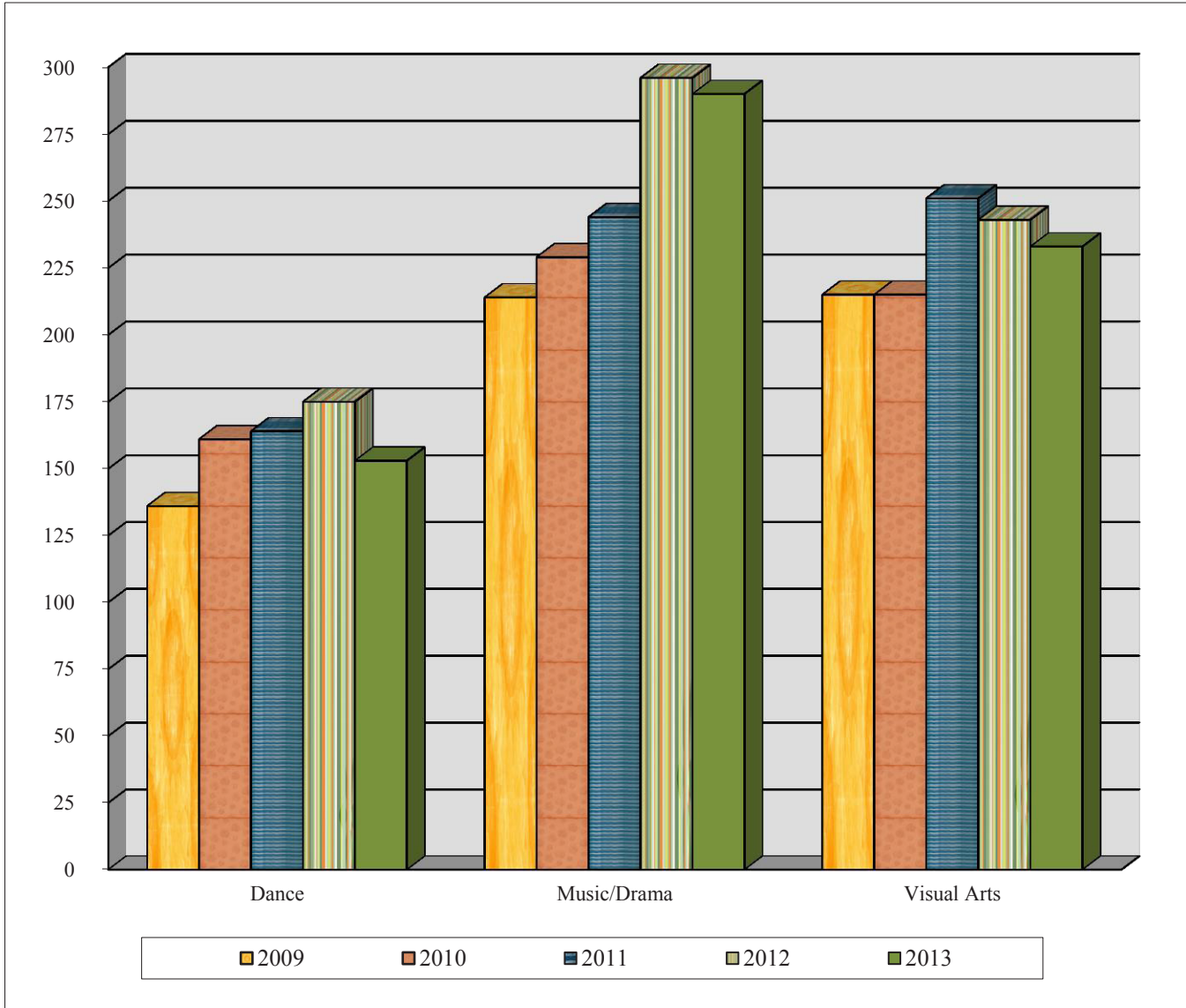

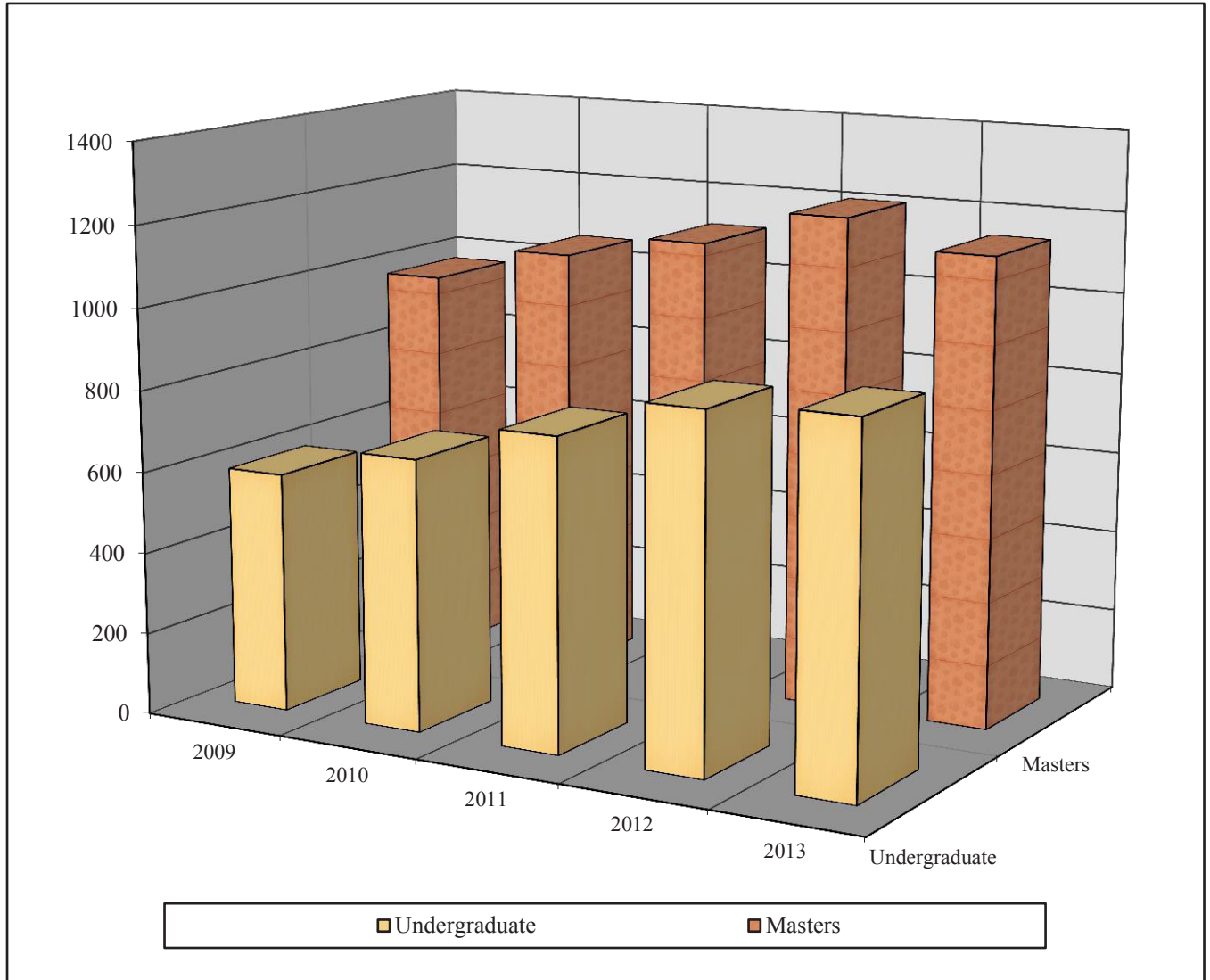

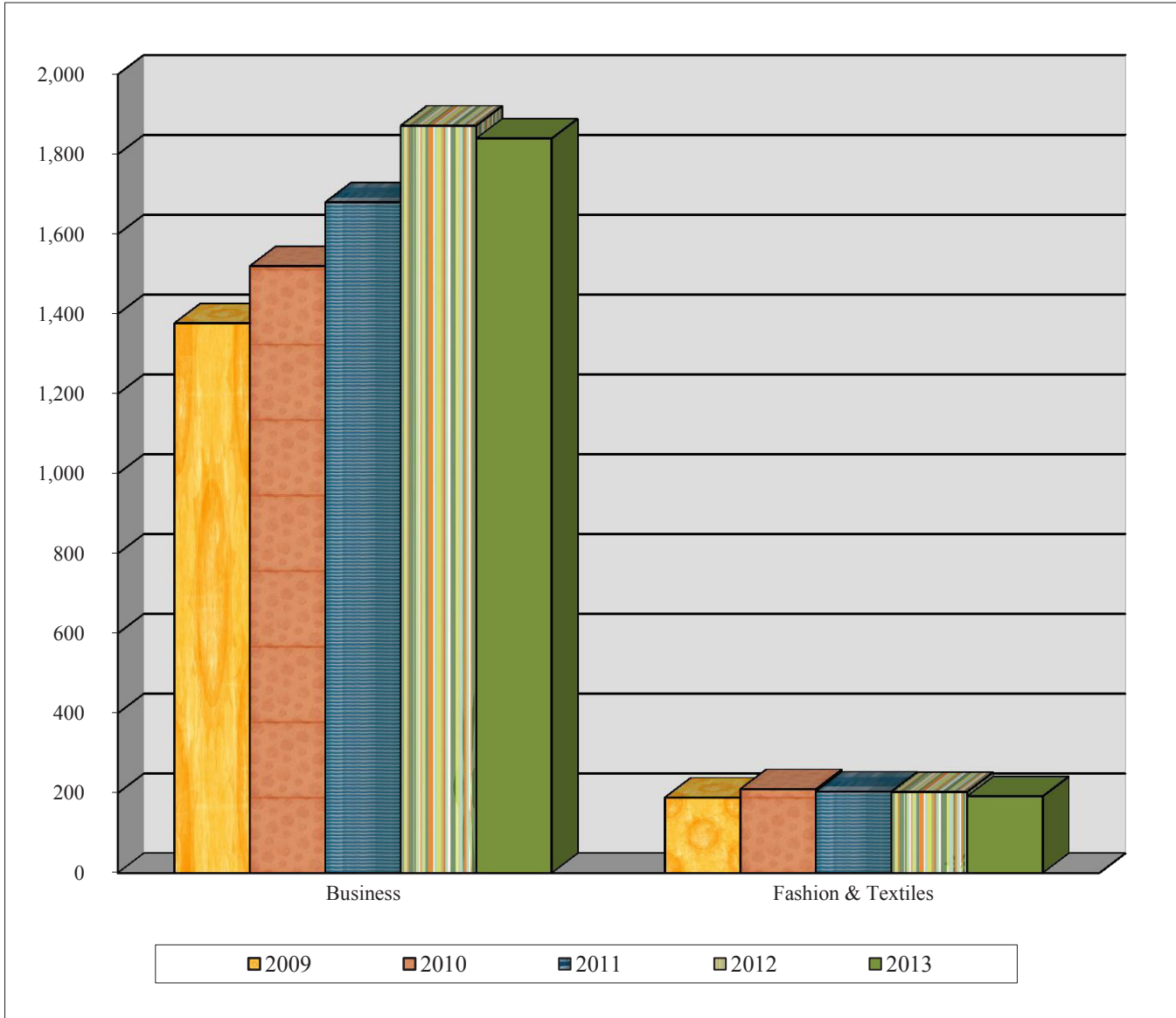

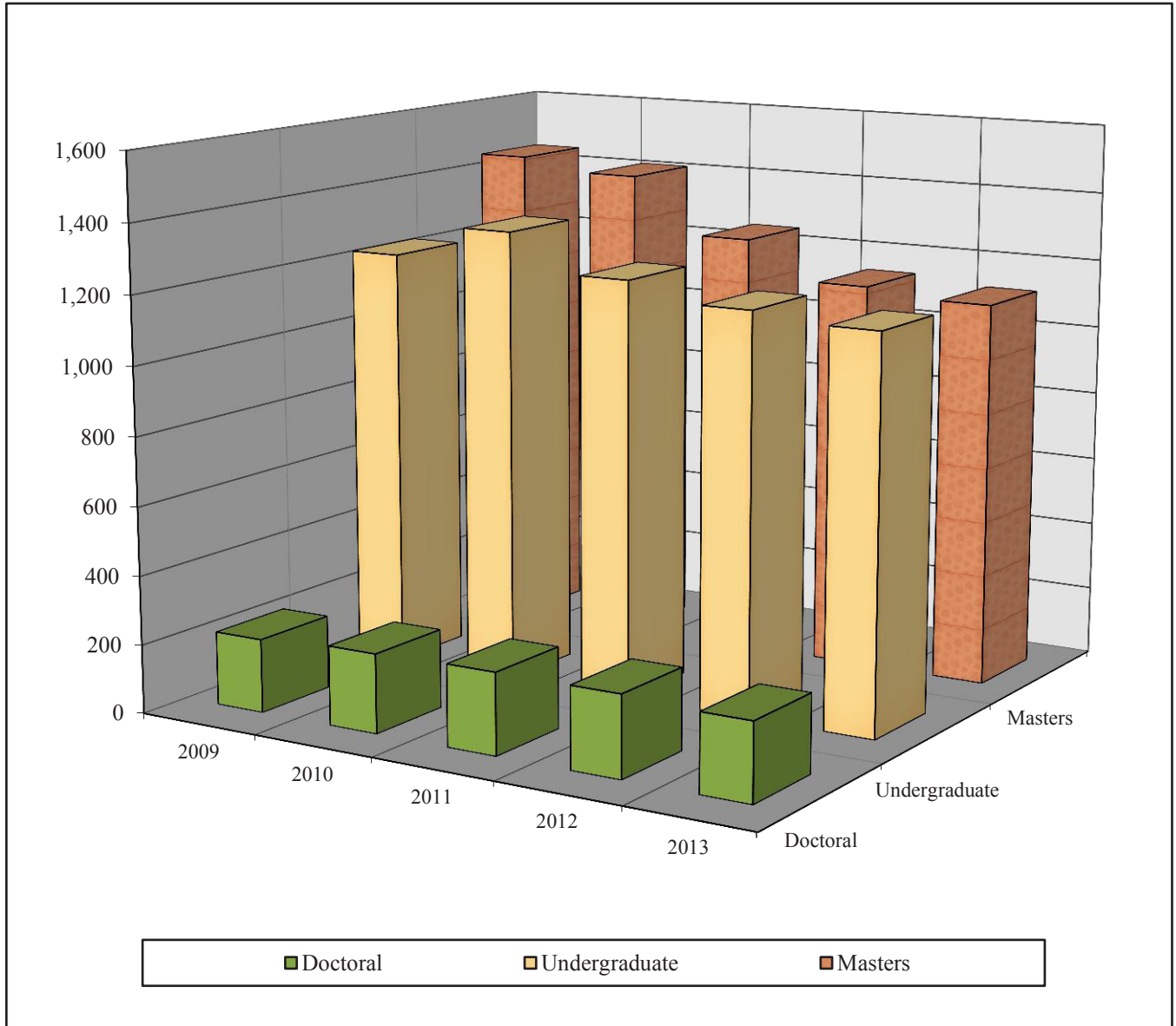

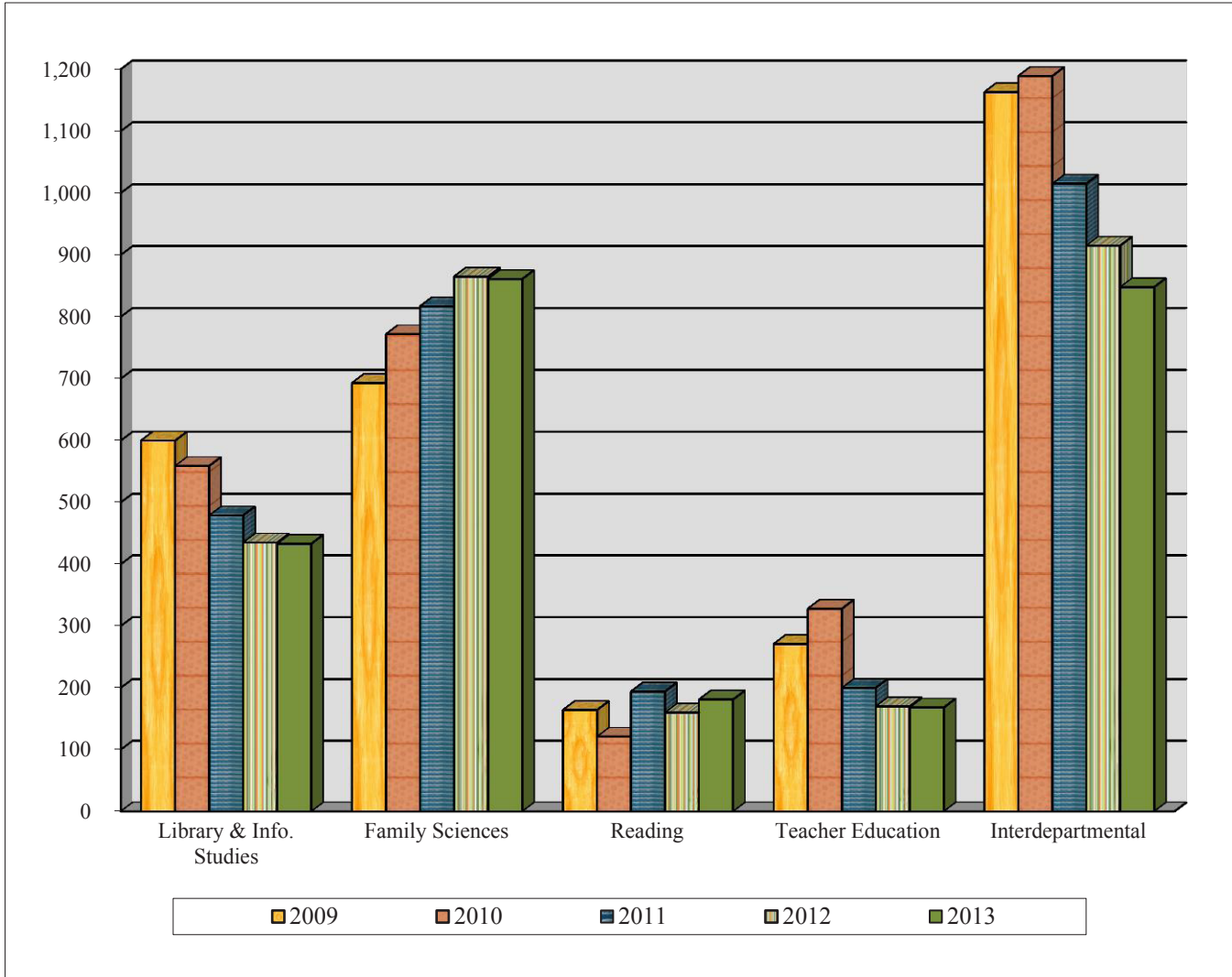

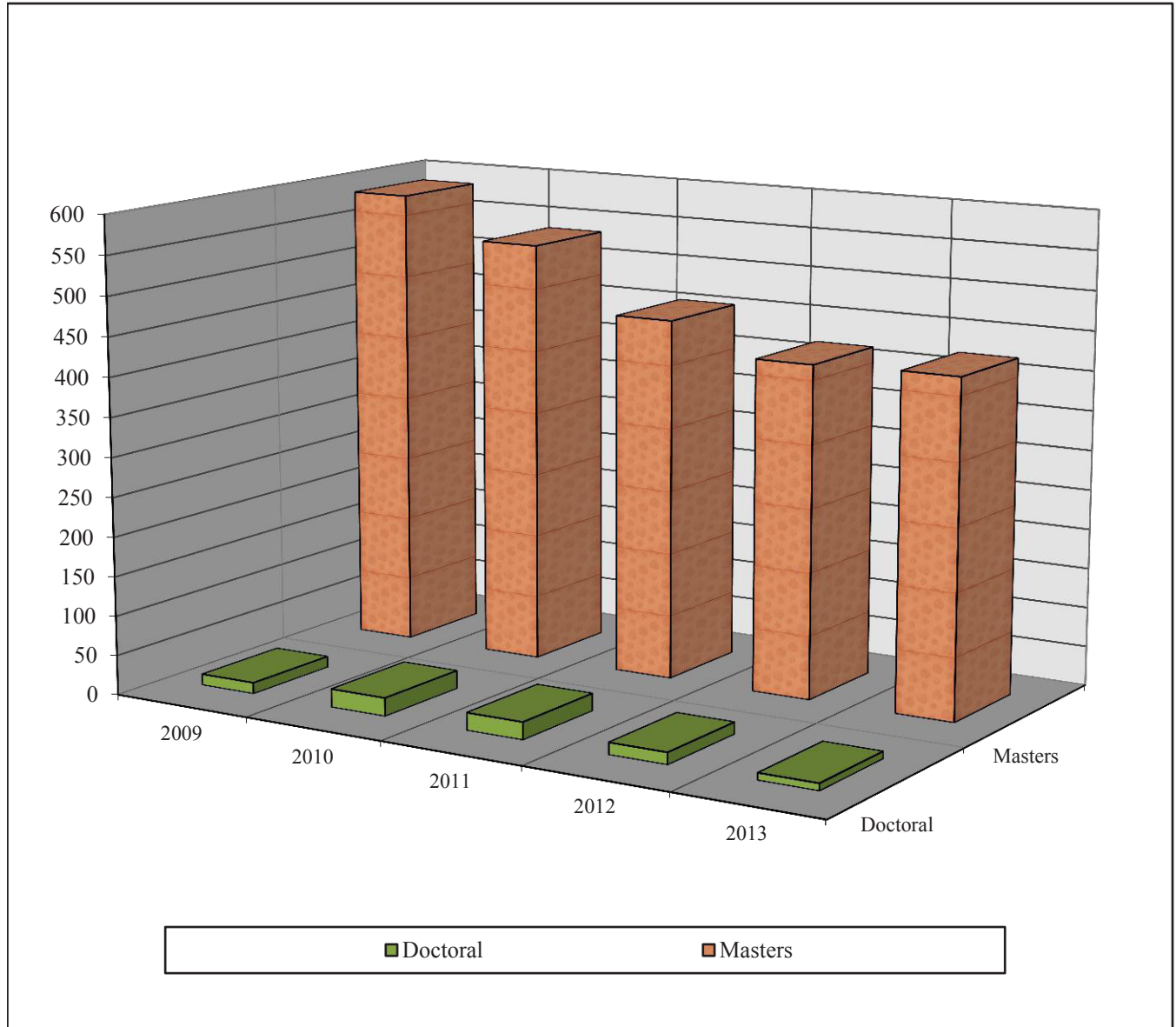

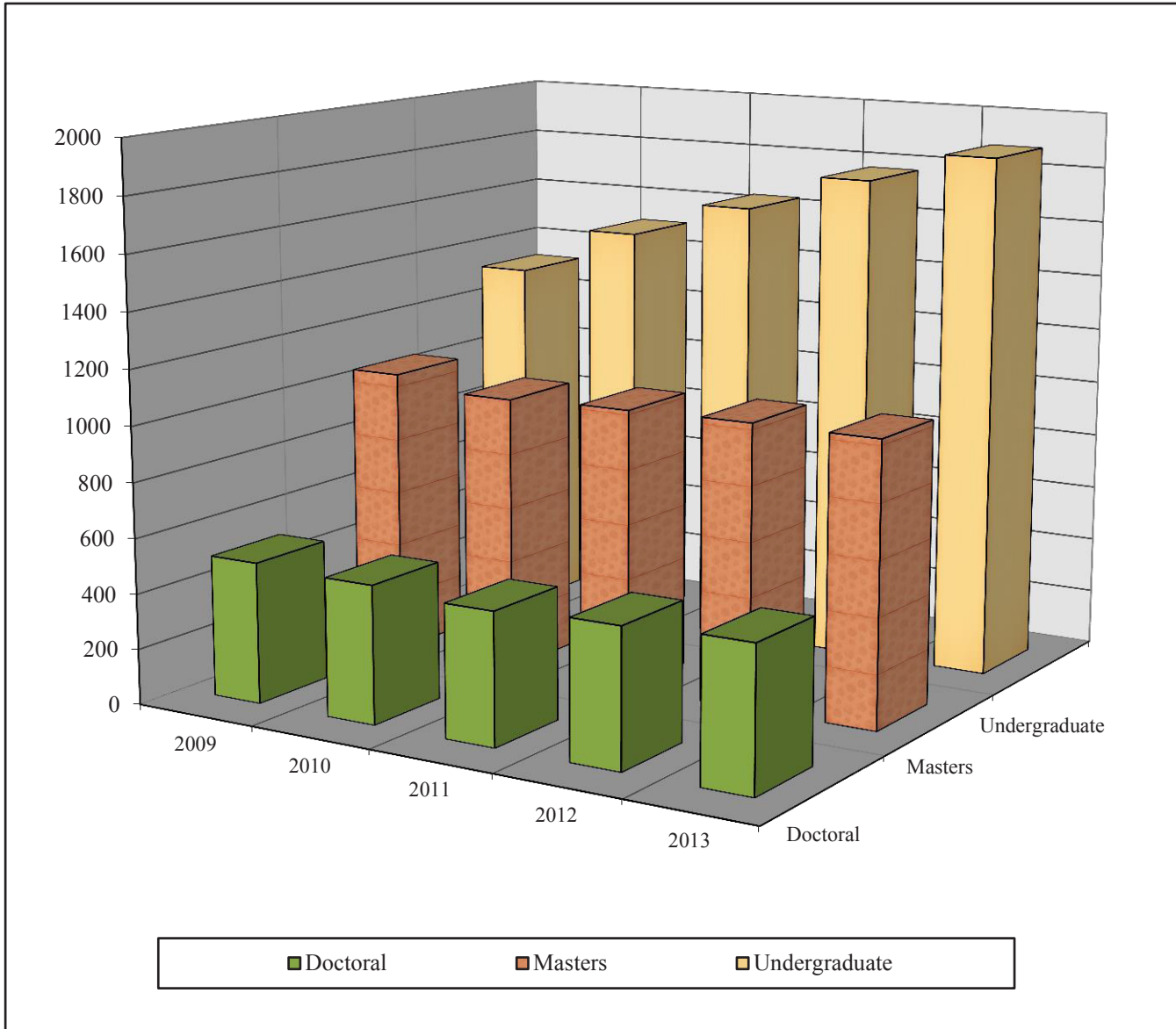

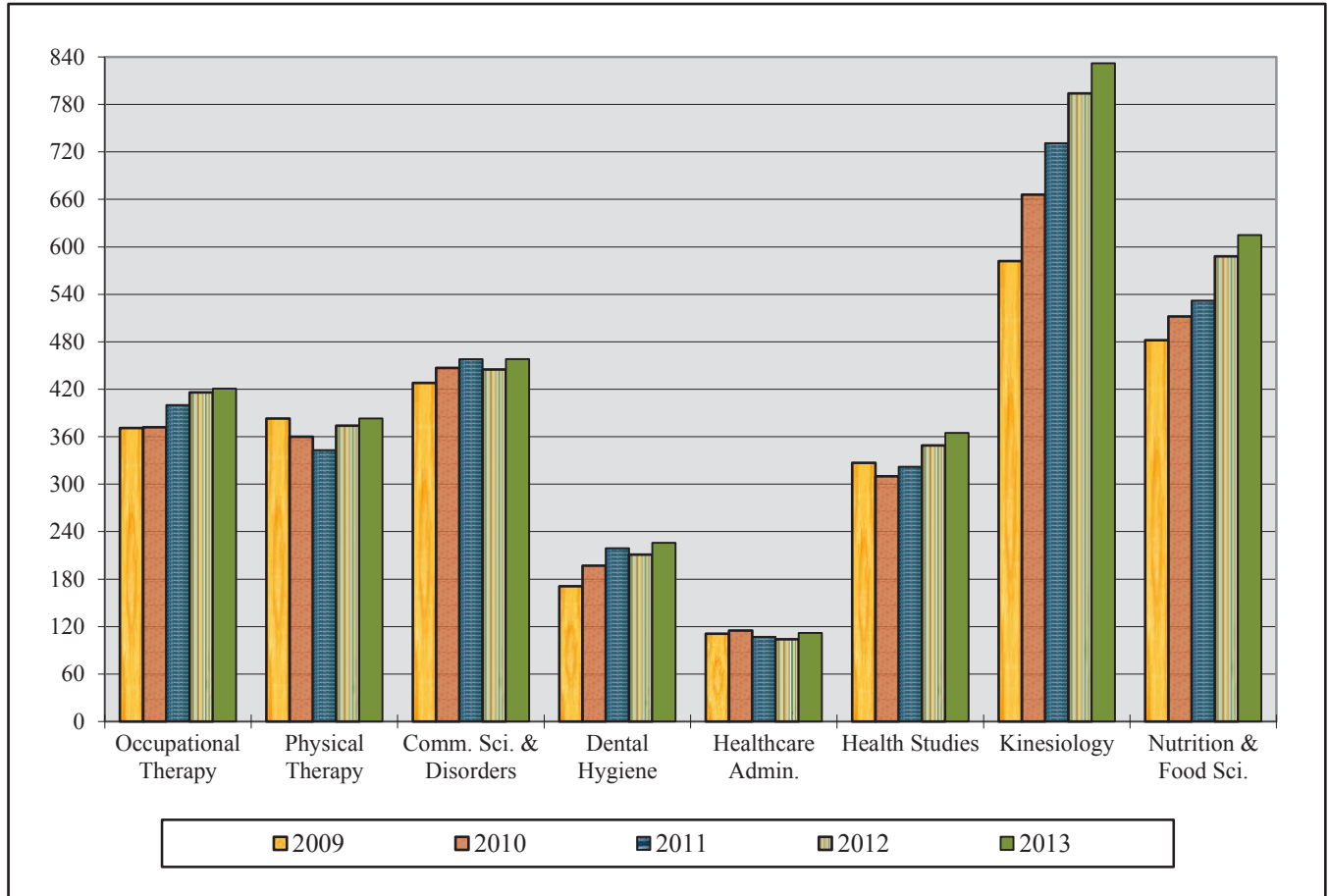

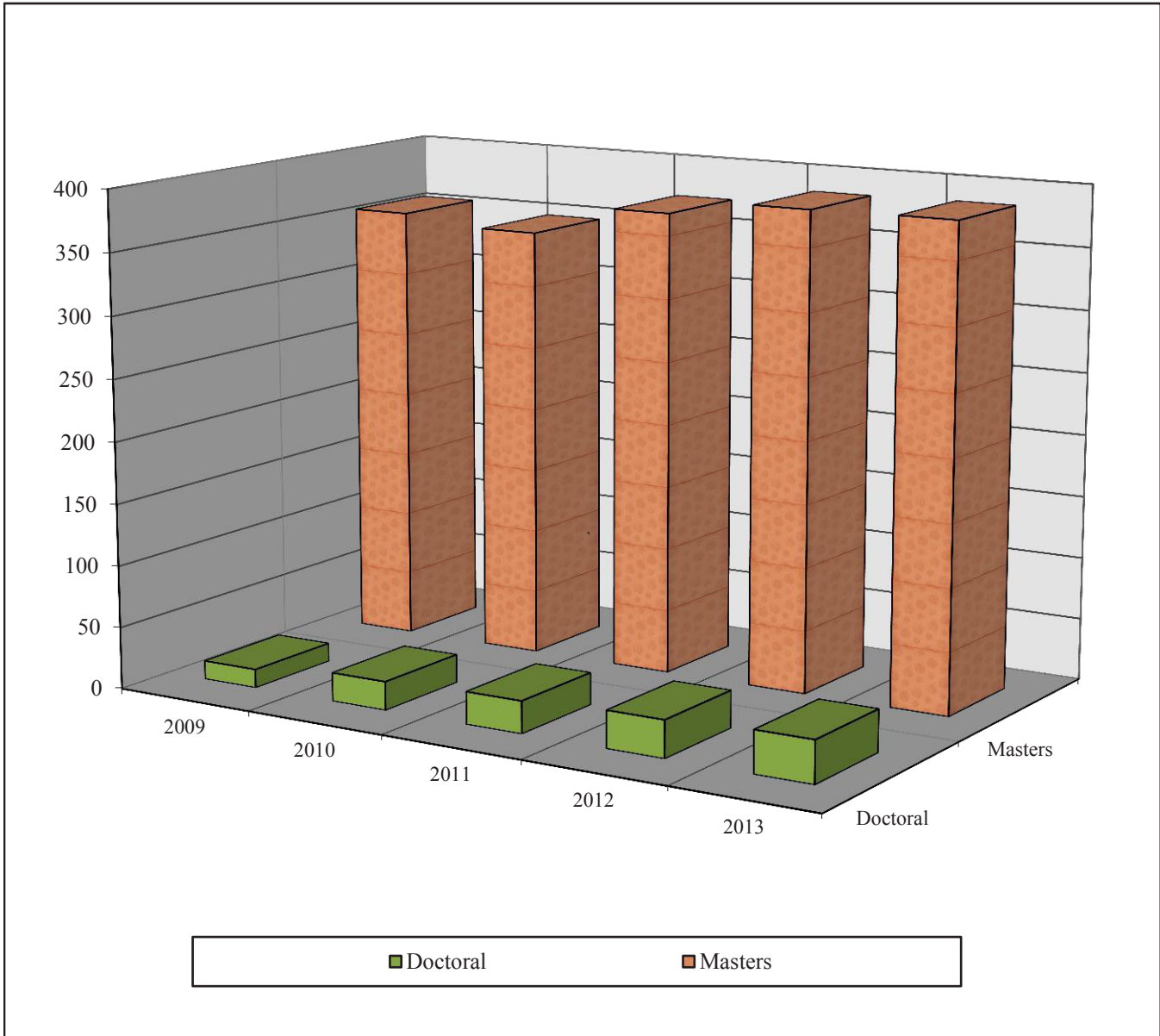

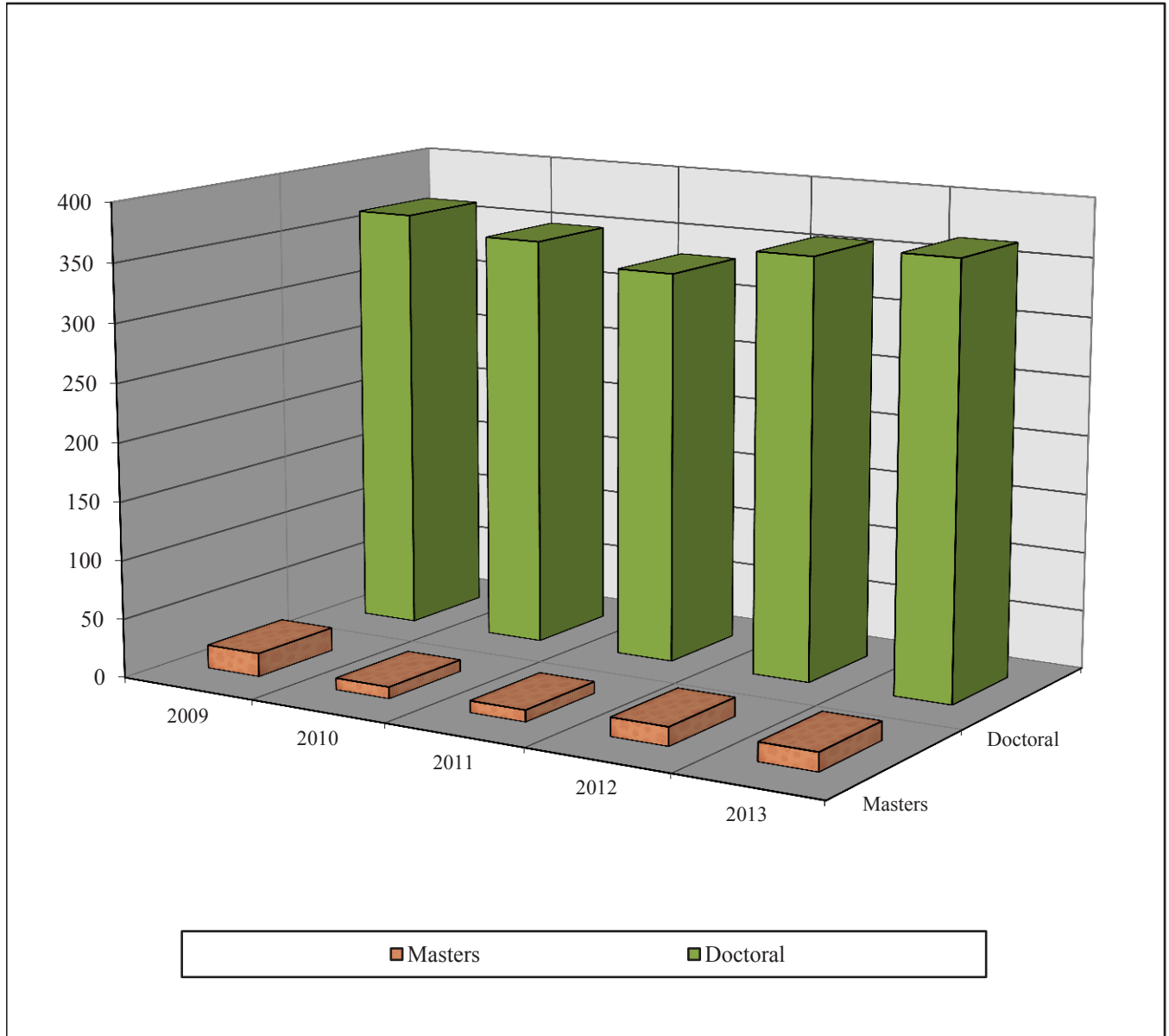

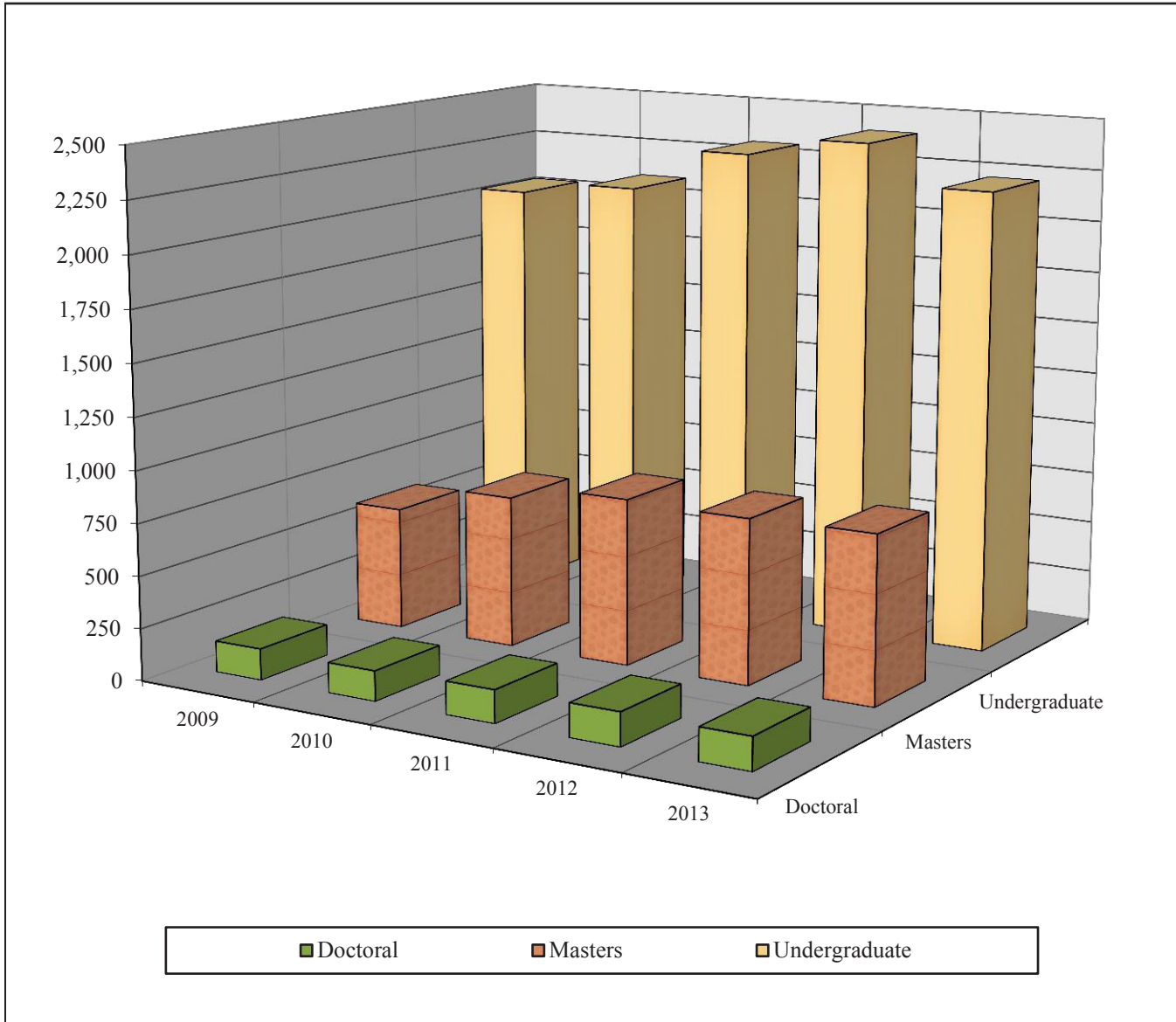

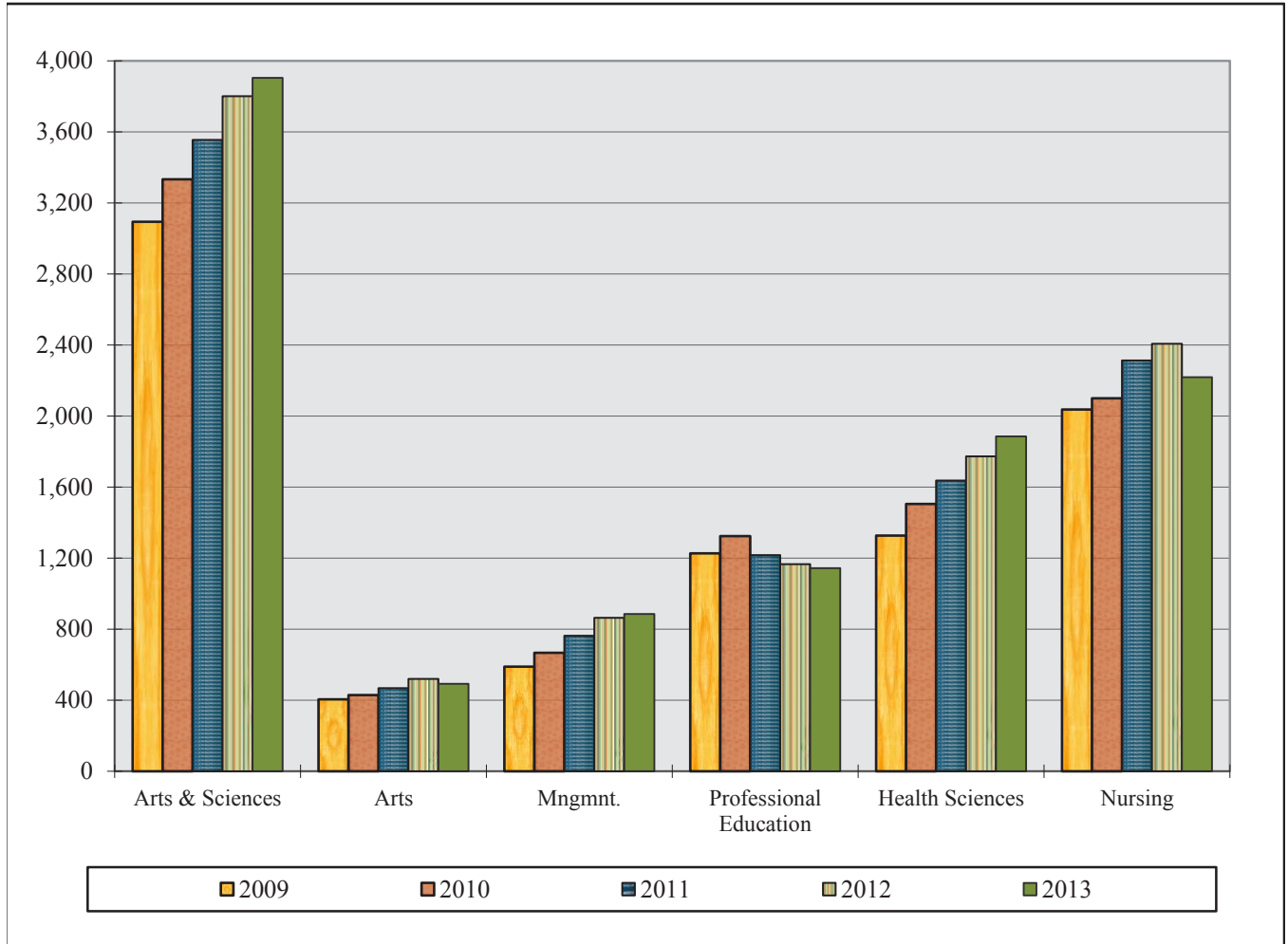

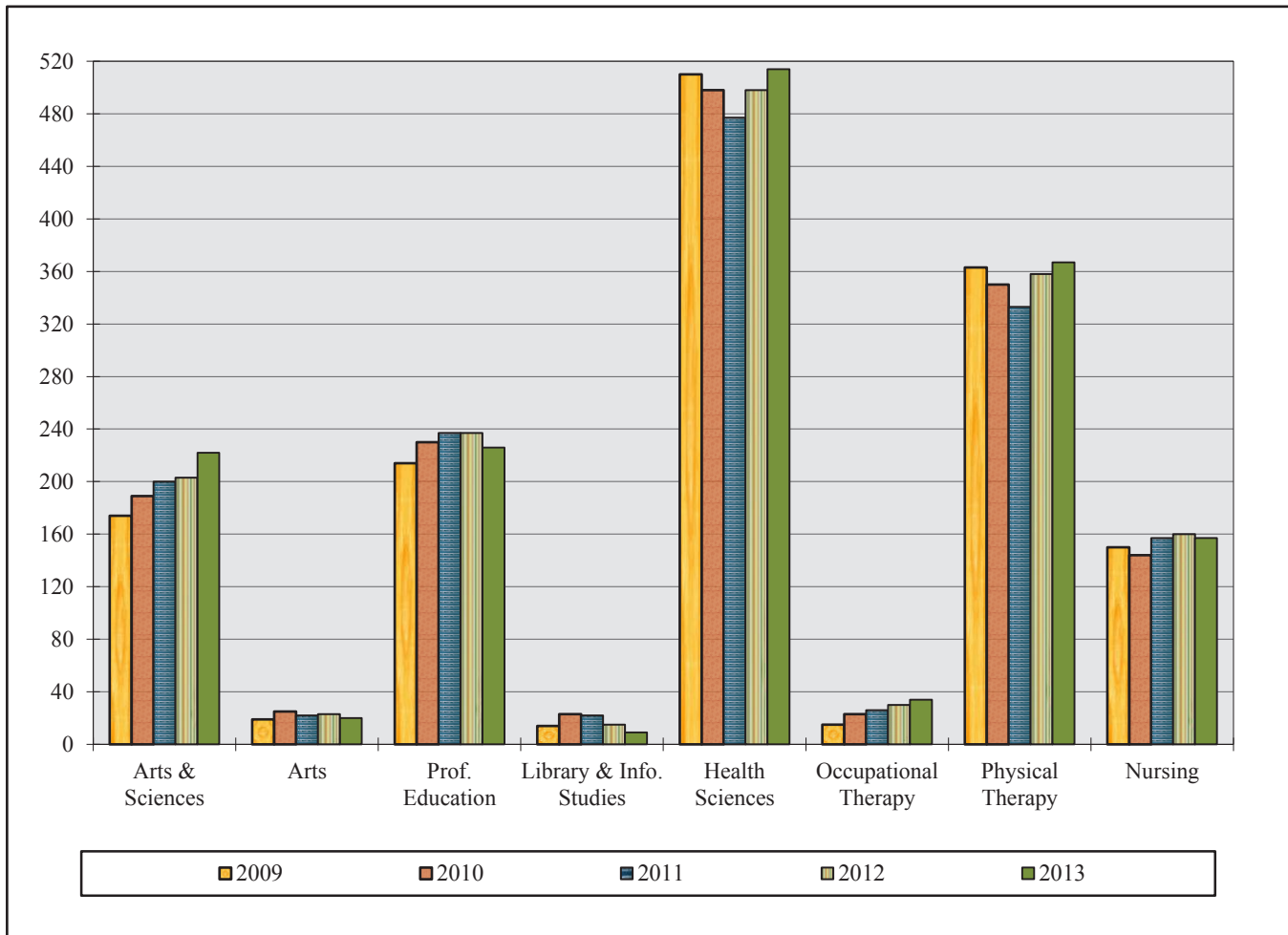
