6. Social Security Number

There can be no changes or substitutions once information has been passed along to the White House. This information will be held in strict confidence and only passed along to the White House (U.S. Secret Service) for background security clearance. In order to process your requests, you must submit this information a minimum of **3 months in advance**.
