Dear Mr. Chairman:

Thank you for your letter of February 11, 2008, co-signed by Chairman John D. Dingell Committee on Energy and Commerce, requesting specific information and documents related to Vytorin (ezetimibe/simvastatin) and the ENHANCE (Effect of Combination Ezetimibe and High-Dose Simvastatin vs. Simvastatin Alone on the Atherosclerotic Process in Subjects With Heterozygous Familial Hypercholesterolemia) trial. This is a partial response.

We have reprinted the questions to which we are now responding in bold.

- 5. All records relating to all Operator Manuals and Reader Manuals for the ENHANCE trial, including but not limited to, the initial Manuals provided to FDA by Merck/Schering-Plough, as well as the final Manuals agreed to by FDA.**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has no responsive documents. There is no requirement for the company to submit Operator Manuals or Reader Manuals to FDA.

- 6. All records relating to any and all amendments to the ENHANCE Operator Manuals and Reader Manuals.**

- 7. All records relating to the analysis, assessment, and approval of the ENHANCE protocol, SAP, Operator Manuals, and Reader Manuals, by FDA officials.**

FDA has no responsive documents. There is no requirement for the company to submit Operator Manuals or Reader Manuals to FDA.


- 9. All Adverse Event Reports related to either Vytorin or Zetia.**
