### OFFERED BY MR. LOEBSACK OF IOWA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

### 1 SEC. 7. FLOOD RISKS TO BRIDGES.

- 2 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of Transportation, in
- 3 consultation with the States, shall conduct a study of the
- 4 risks posed by floods to bridges on Federal-aid highways,
- 5 bridges on other public roads, bridges on Indian reserva-
- 6 tions, and park bridges that are located in a 500-year
- 7 floodplain.
- 8 (b) Considerations.—In conducting the study, the
- 9 Secretary shall give consideration to safety, serviceability,
- 10 essentiality for public use, and public safety, including the
- 11 potential impacts to regional and national freight and pas-
- 12 senger mobility if the serviceability of a bridge is restricted
- 13 or diminished.
