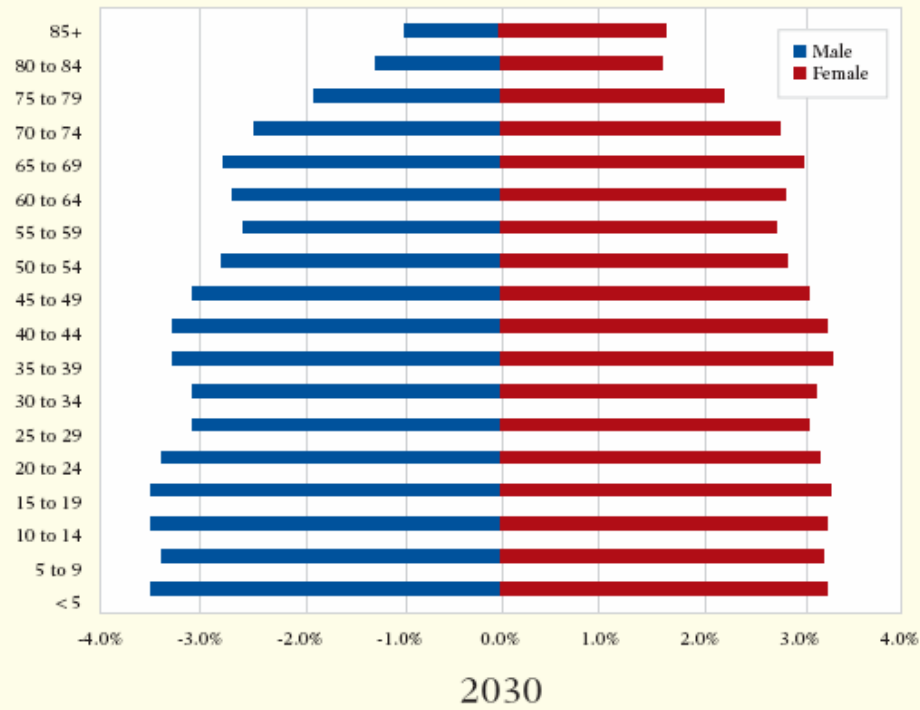
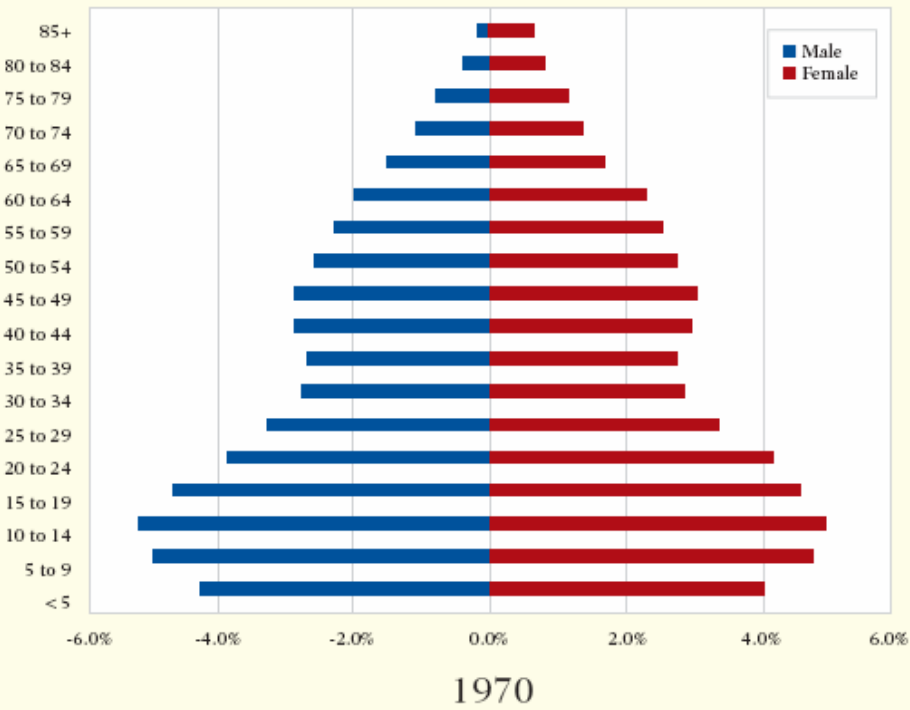

Figure 1. Projected Growth in Elderly Population

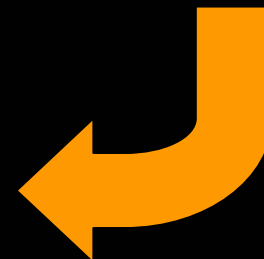

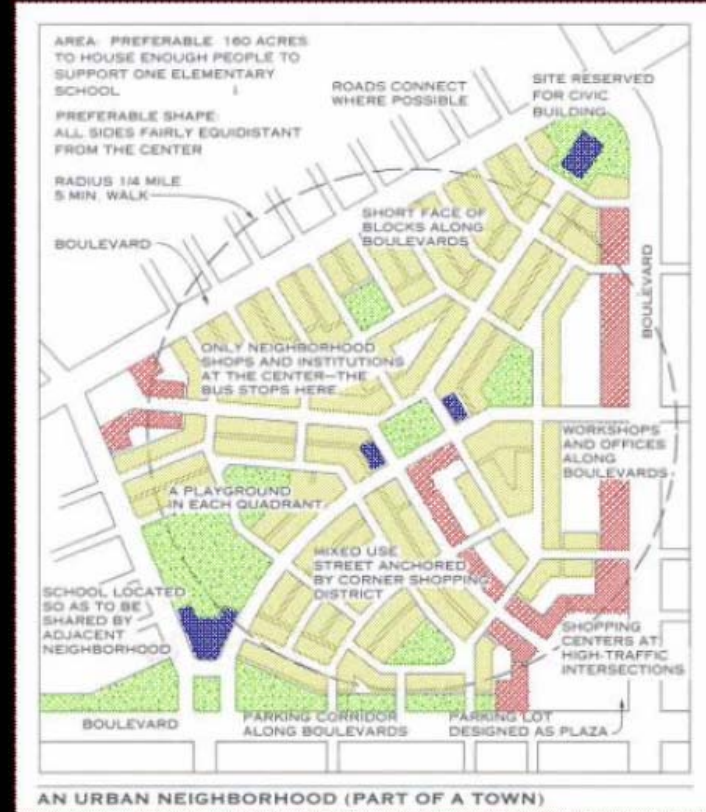

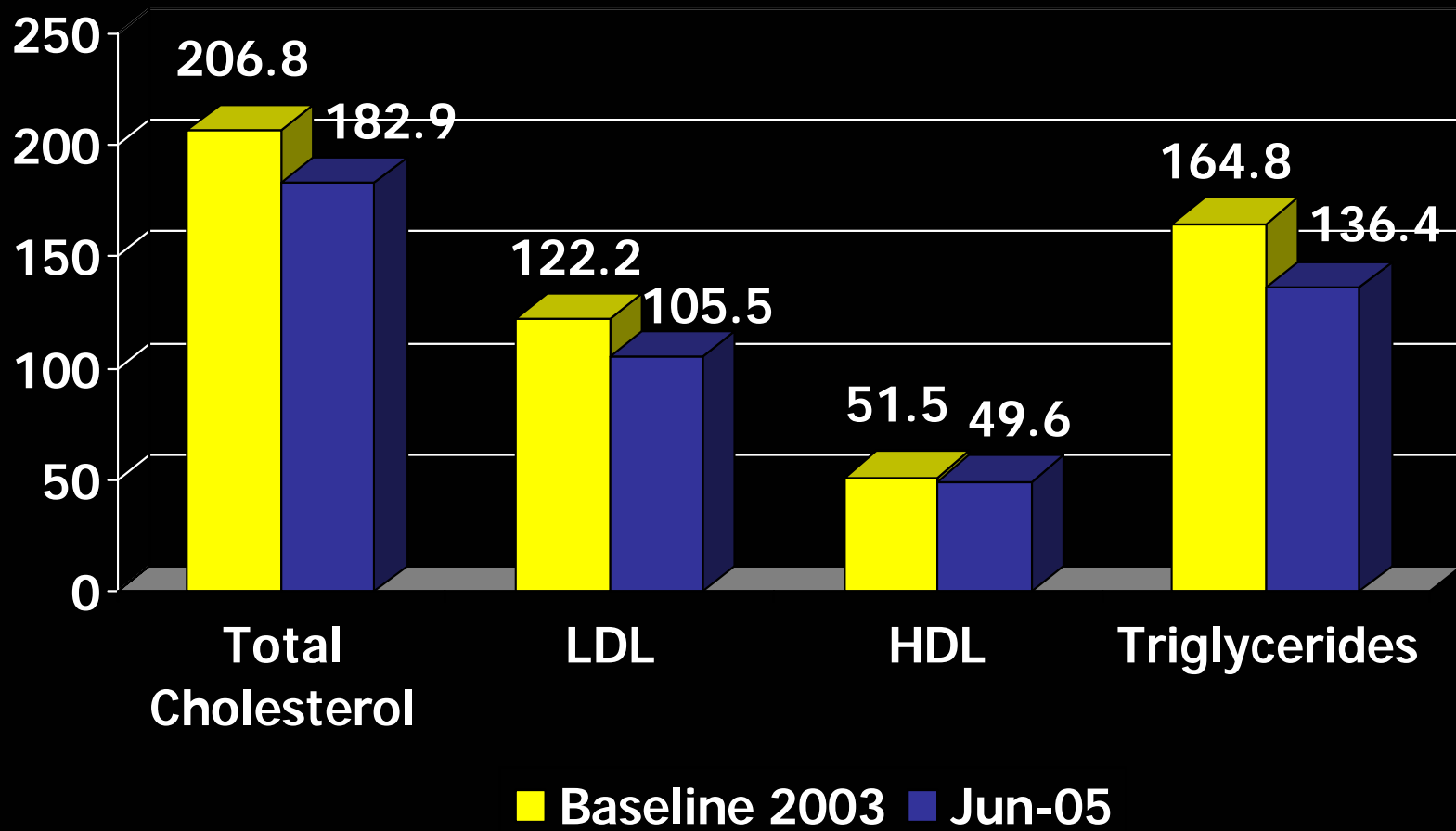
