# DEPARTMENT OF THE TREASURY REPORT TO CONGRESS FY 2005 ACQUISITIONS FROM ENTITIES THAT MANUFACTURE ARTICLES, MATERIALS, OR SUPPLIES OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES

## Introduction

Section 641, Division H of the FY 2005 Consolidated Appropriations Act, Public Law 108-447, provides the annual reporting requirements for the Buy American Act and requires submission of a report to Congress on the amount of acquisitions made by the agency from entities that manufacture the articles, materials, or supplies outside of the United States in that fiscal year.

## Summary

1. Dollar value of articles, materials, or supplies purchased that were manufactured outside of the United States:

Response: The Department of the Treasury purchased items totaling \$838,709 that were manufactured outside of the United States.

2. Itemized list of all waivers granted with respect to such articles, materials, or supplies under the Buy American Act (41 U.S.C. 10a *et seq.*):

Response: Per contract information contained in the Federal Procurement Data System, Treasury made three purchases of supplies for items manufactured outside of the United States in FY 2005 -- one purchase to which the FAR 25.103(b) exception to the Buy American Act applies, one purchase to which the Free Trade Agreement waiver applies, and one purchase to which the World Trade Organization Government Procurement Agreement waiver applies. 3. Summary of the total procurement funds spent on goods manufactured in the United States versus funds spent on goods manufactured outside of the United States:
