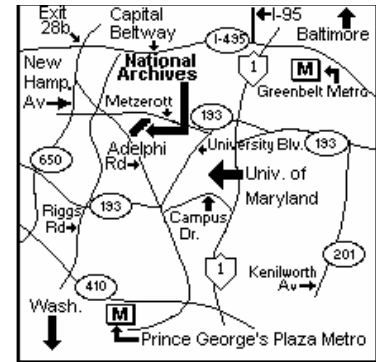

Transportation to College Park

Public Transportation

Metrobus is the Washington metropolitan area transit system and *Metrorail* is the subway system. Metrorail

Archives II: In College Park, take Metrorail's Green Line to the Greenbelt, Fort Totten, or Prince George's Plaza stations, where you can connect with the R3 Metrobus to the National Archives.

University of Maryland: Take Metrorail's Green Line to the College Park Station. Exit the station and take the free UMD shuttle to the student union.

MetroBus

Archives II: Two main Metrobus routes run from Metrorail to NARA's College Park facility: Routes R-3 and C-8.

University of Maryland: Many buses go through campus. Please see the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (<http://www.wmata.com>) or telephone Metro at 202-637-7000.

Driving directions to the NARA-University of Maryland Conference

Conference Day 1: Archives II, 8601 Adelphi Rd, College Park, MD 20740

From I-495 (The Capital Beltway) take exit 28B for New Hampshire Avenue (Route 650) south. Once headed south on New Hampshire, take a left at the second light onto Adelphi Road. Follow Adelphi Road for a couple of miles until you see the large green sign for Archives II on the left. Turn into the entrance.

Conference Parking

At Archives II - Limited visitor parking is available at the Archives II parking garage on both days. Overnight parking is not permitted. If parking at the Archives II garage is full, you will be directed to the overflow lot at the College Park Moose Lodge (see information below). If the Homeland Security Advisory System (HSAS) is raised to the level "Orange" or higher, additional security screening procedures may significantly delay entrance of passenger vehicles.

If you intend to drive and park at Archives II, please note:

A security officer will:

- Check your photo identification (all visitors must present photo ID)
- Direct you to the second entrance of the parking garage
- Provide you with a daily parking permit and instructions on parking.

At the College Park Moose Lodge - 3700 Metzerott Rd, College Park, MD 20740.

Overflow parking will be available approximately one mile away at the College Park Moose Lodge. A shuttle bus will run every 30 minutes to take you from the lot to the Day 1 or Day 2 conference locations.

At University of Maryland

Conference attendees may also choose to park on the University of Maryland campus for Day 2. Please be advised that parking is not free. Union Lane, Mowatt Lane, and Stadium garages are closest to the student union.

The NARA Shuttle Bus between Archives I (Washington DC) and Archives II (College Park, MD)

A NARA shuttle runs between the two National Archives facilities. Conference attendees commuting from Washington DC may use it on a space available basis.

From Archives I, Washington DC: Catch the shuttle at the Metrobus shelter located on 7th Street (between Pennsylvania and Constitution Avenues) from 8 am - 5 pm **on the hour**.

From Archives II, College Park: Catch the shuttle at the front entrance of the Archives II building from 8 am - 5 pm **on the hour**.
