## 106 Essentials Course: Houston, TX

*The Section 106 Essentials* course will be held on Wednesday, January 16 and Thursday, January 17, 2008

**Important note:** Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

**Course Location and Accommodations:** The course is being held at the Hyatt Regency Downtown Houston, 1200 Louisiana Street, Houston, Texas, 77002, 713-654-1234 (http://houstonregency.hyatt.com/hyatt/hotels/index.jsp).

A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Tuesday, January 15 and Wednesday, January 16 for the government rate of \$102 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (17%). It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by December 15, 2007. Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. To reserve your room, call the hotel directly at 1-800-233-1234 and state that you are with the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation Section 106 Essentials Course and ask for the rate of \$102. If our room block is sold out, you can find additional hotels at online hotel booking websites. Searching for sites for Houston in zip code 77002 is recommended.

## Airport Ground Transportation:

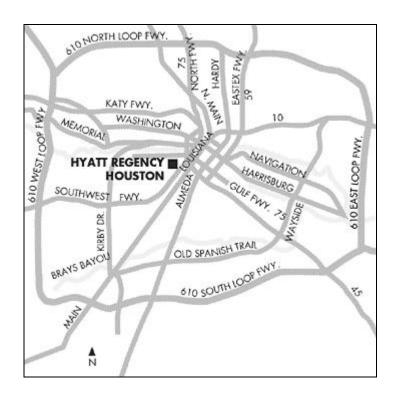
- To/From George Bush Intercontinental Airport: Visitors to Bush Intercontinental Airport have a variety of transfer and transportation options available to them once they arrive in Houston. This includes taxis, private limousines, SuperShuttle shared-ride service, scheduled buses/shuttles, courtesy vans, and public bus (METRO) transportation. Taxis can be hailed by Ground Transportation staff outside each terminal. Cost: approximately \$35.00 \$40.00.

This includes taxis, limousines, SuperShuttle shared-ride, scheduled ground transportation shuttles, hotel/motel courtesy vans, and even public (METRO bus) transportation. ## **Directions to Hyatt Regency:**

- From George Bush Intercontinental Airport (26 miles): Take Beltway 8 west to I-45 South. Exit at McKinney (left). Take McKinney to Milam. Turn right. Proceed 3 blocks to Polk. Cross Louisiana Street and enter motor lobby on right at the corner of Louisiana and Polk.
- From Hobby Airport (12 miles): Take 45 North and exit Scott St onto St. Joseph Pkwy. Turn right on Louisiana St. The hotel will be on your left.
- From Points East: Take I-10 west, then merge onto I-45 South. Follow remaining directions from George Bush Intercontinental Airport to hotel.
- **From Points North:** Take I-45 South. Follow remaining directions from George Bush Intercontinental Airport to hotel.

• **From Points West:** Take I-10 east, then merge onto I-45 South. Follow remaining directions from George Bush Intercontinental Airport to hotel.



**Parking Rates at Hyatt Regency:** *Overnight Valet Parking*: \$25 per night. Includes taxes and in/out privileges. *Self-Parking*: \$15.00 per day. This is a city-owned parking lot next door to the hotel. No in/out privileges.

**Local Information**: Set in the heart of the business and entertainment districts, the Hyatt Regency Downtown Hotel is the ideal starting point for exploring all that Houston offers. **Attire for Training Course:** Attire for the course is casual. Also, please keep in mind that hotel meeting rooms tend to be cool, so plan to bring a sweater or jacket.

**Cancellations:** If made at least 14 days prior to the start of the course, registrants who cancel will receive a full refund minus a 15% processing fee. No refunds will be given for cancellations made fewer than 14 days before the start of the course; however, substitutions may be made at no cost up until three days before the course begins.
