The National Advanced Fire & Resource Institute (NAFRI) is a national level center for strategic planning, development, and implementation of incident management skills and techniques under the guidance of the National Wildfire Coordinating Group made up of the USDA Forest Service; four Department of Interior agencies: Bureau of Land Management (BLM), National Park Service (NPS), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), and the Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS); and State forestry agencies through the National Association of State Foresters.

In addition to the NAFRI regularly supported courses, rooms for meetings, conferences, and training, including the Sonoran Auditorium and a faculty workroom, are available for reservation to qualifying organizations. The large classroom area can be divided into eight classrooms. The Sonoran Auditorium has 130 seats, participant microphones, and in-table electrical connections for laptops.
