




Mission

DISA Net-Centric Enterprise Services





What's on the Horizon?

- Collaboration Services:
 - DISA Strategy is to provide the DoD the Power of Choice Acquisition Approach:
 - Button 1 E-Collab Center contract expires FEB 2010.
 - Button 2 Defense Connect Online contract expires OCT 2010.
- Current Status:
 - Consolidating/refining requirements from user communities. (Ongoing effort)
 - Planning activities for follow-on Contracts
- Upcoming Events
 - Release RFI (4th quarter FY08)
 - Conduct an Industry Day (4th quarter FY08)
 - Plan to release RFP (1st quarter FY09)



- Net-Centric Enterprise Services is looking for industry partners' support to implement DoD/IC enterprise services:
