In Appendix B, Section D.2.c.(1): Does the exclusion language prohibit anyone with "detailed knowledge of the MEO" from serving on the SSEB, or is MEO an adjective so that the exclusion is limited to those with "detailed knowledge of the MEO...Cost Estimate."

If the language intends to exclude anyone with detailed knowledge of the MEO, how will OMB advise agencies to find adequate expertise to evaluate technical proposals for unique, specialized groups (like libraries) whose entire staff may have participated at some level in the MEO proposal?
