#### Abstract

An Act

\section*{SEC. 401. AMENDMENT TO CONTRIBUTIONS.}

Section 4 of the National Commission on Libraries and Information Science Act (20 U.S.C. 1503) is amended by striking ' 'accept, hold, administer, and utilize gifts, bequests, and devises of property,’’ and inserting 'solicit, accept, hold, administer, invest in the name of the United States, and utilize gifts, bequests, and devises of services or property,' .


## SEC. 402 AMENDMENT TO MEMBERSHIP.

Section 6(a) of the National Commission on Libraries and Information Science Act (20 U.S.C. 1505(a)) is amended--
(1) in the second sentence, by striking `and at least one other of whom shall be knowledgeable with respect to the library and information service and science needs of the elderly'; (2) by striking the fourth sentence and inserting the following: `A majority of members of the Commission who have taken office and are serving on the Commission shall constitute a quorum for conduct of business at official meetings of the Commission'; and
(3) in the fifth sentence, by striking `five years, except that' and all that follows through the period and inserting `five years, except that--
(1) a member of the Commission appointed to fill a vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term for which the member's predecessor was appointed, shall be appointed only for the remainder of such term; and `(2) any member of the Commission may continue to serve after an expiration of the member's term of office until such member's successor is appointed, has taken office, and is serving on the Commission.'.

## SEC. 505. REPEALS.

(a) NATIONAL COMMISSION ON LIBRARIES AND INFORMATION SCIENCE

ACT- Section 5 of the National Commission on Libraries and Information Science Act (20 U.S.C. 1504) is amended--
(1) by striking subsections (b) and (c); and
(2) by redesignating subsections (d), (e), and (f) as subsections (b), (c), and (d), respectively.
