Agreed Upon Procedures on Indirect Cost Rates Proposed by the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs

As part of the overall audit of the National Endowment for Democracy, the Office of Inspector General contracted with an independent auditor to perform agreed-upon procedures on indirect cost rates submitted by the National Democratic Institute for International Affairs (NDI) for the year ended September 30, 2005. The objective was to provide recommended final rates for that year for use in reimbursing costs incurred under awards made to NDI by the Department of State (Department). The independent auditor took no exceptions to the proposed rates.

The independent auditor recommended that the Department use the proposed rates for purposes of determining the final costs incurred by NDI during the year ended September 30, 2005, under awards made by the Department to NDI.
