Notes for PACER Users

Bankruptcy Version 2.7 ESR (11/28/05)

This document summarizes the changes you will notice after November 28, 2005 when you use CM/ECF in a U. S. Bankruptcy Court. After that date, emergency changes needed to the software released as V2.7 for the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 2005 may be installed by the court.

Notices

- Users get an erroneous NEF subject line in the trustee 341 batch events. The correct subject line for each event is now displayed.
- When two or more BNC Certificate of Mailings are processed for the same case on the same night, the second (and subsequent) NEF points the user to the first certificate of mailing. The user did not get their free look at the correct BNC certificate of service event. The NEF now points to the correct certificate of mailing.
- Sometimes multiple docket transactions for a single case processed in a batch run caused the NEF to display the same data. When the certificate from the BNC or the Automatic Discharge/Closing event is automatically docketed, the *text* receipt does not contain the document information. All of these issues have been corrected.
- When multi-case docketing to adversary cases, the AP case number was omitted from the NEF, where it used to be included. This problem has been corrected.
- The CM/ECF *Notice of Bankruptcy Case Filing* "Creditors May not take Certain Actions" paragraph was updated to reflect the new official form language.
