



Supporting Local and Regional Decision

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's policy to involve local communities as early as possible in the decision-making process and enhance its efforts in the environmental restoration activities prompted the formation of a Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) at the Pribilof Islands. The RAB has become a significant component of the community involvement activities in the Environmental Restoration Program at the Islands.

The RAB is composed of local community stakeholders. State and local government agencies, and a representative from NOAA. The RAB adopted the principle of "CO-chairs" to foster the working partnership of the RAB. One CO-chair represents the NOAA and the other CO-chair is selected by the community.

The RAB serves a twofold purpose. First, the RAB provides a forum through which representatives of the community. installation, and regulatory agencies discuss and exchange information regarding the Environmental Restoration Program at the Islands. Second, the RAB gives the stakeholders the opportunity to participate in the cleanup process and make their views known to decision-makers.

The RAB serves as an important part of other community involvement activities ongoing at the depot. Other activities include the public notices, fact sheets, newsletters, public meetings, and information repositories.

This site provides information concerning RAB activities, which includes upcoming meeting schedules and meeting minutes.
