CORPS AUTHORITIES AND PORTFIELDS

Portfields = Opportunity to leverage Corps programs and authorities to revitalize waterfront areas in interagency efforts.

BELLINGHAM PORTFIELDS REDEVELOPMENT PLANS

- Acquire & redevelop surplus industrial property
- Restore estuarine habitat
- Remediate contaminated marine sediments
- Design & construct transportation infrastructure
- Minimize dredging in federal channels
- Establish a federal facility to enhance border security (new USCG facility)
- Planned waterfront stewardship institute
