

El Salvador Compact Progress

- ★ Human Development Project: FOMILENIO continues implementation of the Education and Training pilot providing scholarships to 115 post-secondary and middle technical schools students from the Northern Zone in the areas of tourism, agriculture and IT. Two procurements of electrification works are underway for the Community Infrastructure Activity for a total of \$2,410.00.
- ★ Productive Development Project: This project's pilot awarded 10 grants for a total of \$5 million to provide technical assistance and business development services to approximately 1,600 farmers and small businesses in the Northern Zone. The objective is to increase their productivity. Procurement for the project's main implementation contract is underway.
- ★ Connectivity Project: Procurement is underway for the Connectivity Project Manager contract. The procurement process is also

underway to conduct final design and resettlement action plan for sections of the Northern Transnational Highway.

 ★ Other Highlights: Building on CAFTA and MCC's compact with El Salvador, the US Trade and Development Agency signed three grant agreements totaling \$1.1 million with El Salvador's National Development Commission, the Salvadoran Foundation for Economic and Social Development and the Municipality of Chalatenango. The grants will promote trade and investment in the Northern Zone.

The 3rd outreach event for Salvadorans Living Abroad took place in New York on July 22. This series of events brings together MCC, the Government of El Salvador, FOMILENIO and the private sector to showcase opportunities created through El Salvador's MCC compact.
