



Program Summary

Uganda's program is focused on fighting corruption by improving public procurement and financial management practices, increasing the effectiveness of investigations and prosecutions and strengthening the role of civil society.

Program Highlights

- The Uganda Threshold program has finalized the scope of work and manpower requirements for the 17 required procurement audits to be undertaken during the program.
- The National Fraud Squad participated in a workshop in public financial management.
- Sixty-nine newly recruited state attorneys in the Department of Public Prosecutions received two weeks of extensive training in trial advocacy skills, with corruption used as a learning tool in the test cases, moot courts, etc.
- Consultative meetings with the Principal Judge, the Registrar of the High Court, and the Executive Director of the Judicial Studies Institute were held.
- Four people from ten civil society organizations and four media organizations underwent a four-day training of trainers course on conducting Public Expenditure Tracking Surveys.
