AmeriCorps NCCC, a team-based national service program for young adults, is seeking idealistic, community-minded individuals with demonstrated leadership experience to serve as Team Leaders at the new North Central Region campus in Vinton, Iowa.

As a Team Leader, you will:

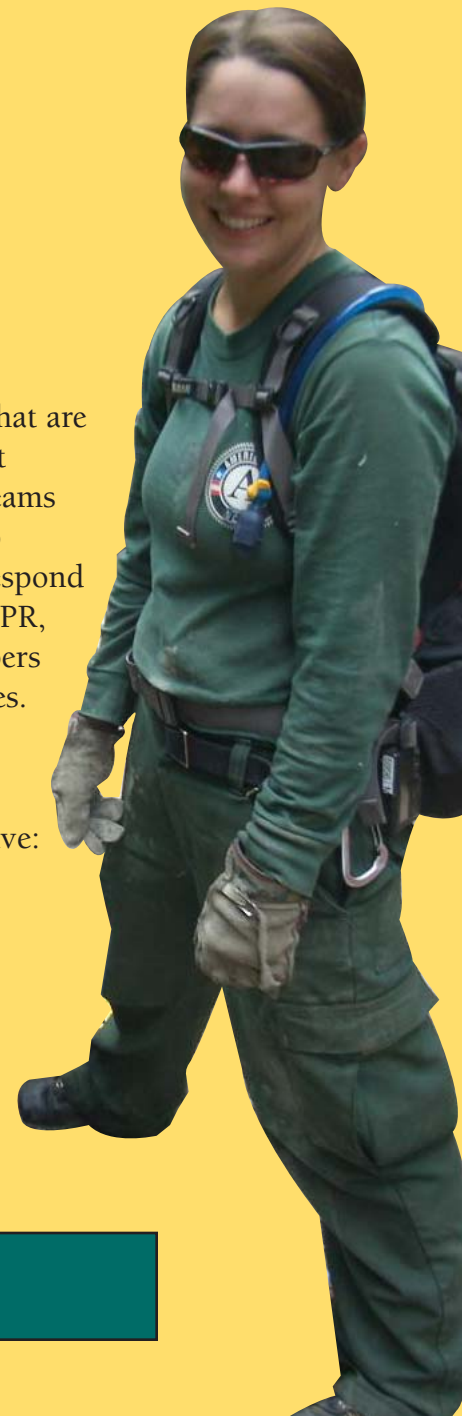
- Manage the day-to-day activities of 8-12 corps members
- Serve as a role model, facilitator, and educator
- Plan project schedules
- Lead trainings
- Foster teamwork and positive morale
- Ensure the safety and well-being of members

National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC) teams respond to needs that are identified by local and national nonprofit organizations and government agencies. Assigned to a series of projects that last 6-8 weeks each, the teams construct and rehabilitate low-income housing, tutor students, clean up streams, clear trails, help communities develop emergency plans, and respond to disasters, among many other activities. NCCC teams are trained in CPR, first aid, disaster response, and firefighting. Approximately 1,100 members serve with NCCC across the country each year at four regional campuses.

Team Leader Benefits

In exchange for an 11-month commitment, NCCC Team Leaders receive:

- Living allowance of \$12,500
- Room and board
- Education award of \$4,725
- Student loan forbearance
- Limited health benefits
- \$500 relocation expenses
- The satisfaction of leading a team that is making a difference!



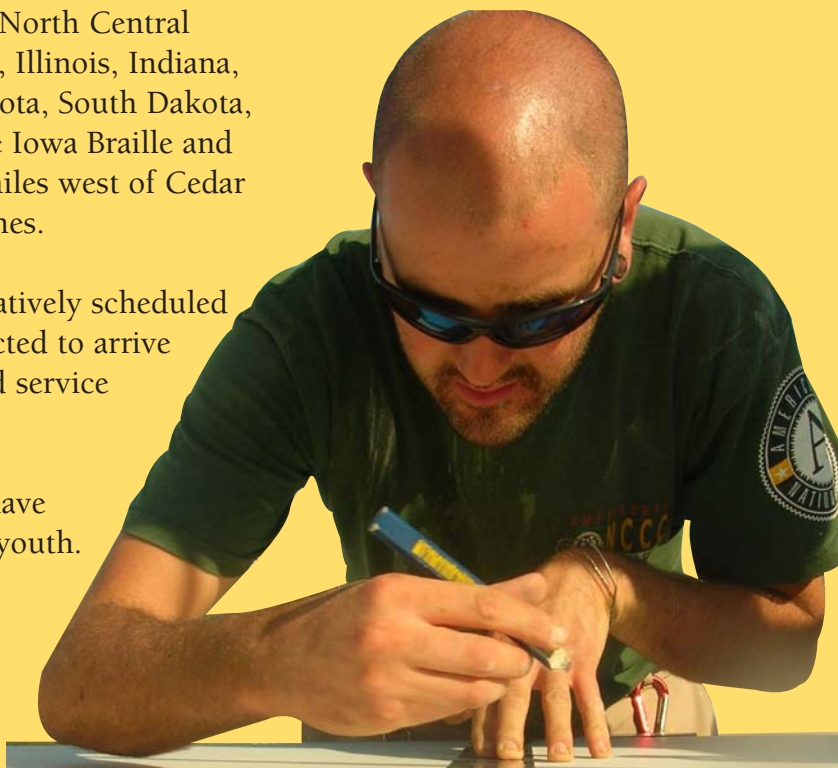

Iowa Campus Information

The new Iowa campus will serve the entire North Central Region of the United States, including Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Ohio, and Wisconsin. It will be based at the Iowa Braille and Sight Saving School in Vinton, located 32 miles west of Cedar Rapids and 112 miles northeast of Des Moines.

A month-long Team Leader Training is tentatively scheduled to begin June 10. Corps Members are projected to arrive on July 10 for member training. Team-based service projects are slated to begin August 1.

Successful Team Leader applicants should have prior supervisory experience working with youth. Graduates of service programs such as AmeriCorps (including VISTA and NCCC), youth corps, the Peace Corps, and the U.S. military are especially invited to apply.
