WHOLESALE RATES FOR HYDRO POWER AND ENERGY
SOLD TO SAM RAYBURN MUNICIPAL POWER AGENCY
(CONTRACT NO. DE-PM75-85SW00117)

Effective:

During the period January 1, 2007, through September 30, 2010, in accordance with the Order of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued February 23, 2007 (Docket No. EF07-4081-000).

Applicable:

To the power and energy purchased by Sam Rayburn Municipal Power Agency (SRMPA) from the Southwestern Power Administration (Southwestern) under the terms and conditions of the Power Sales Contract dated June 28, 1985, for the sale of all Hydro Power and Energy generated at the Robert Douglas Willis Hydropower Project (Robert D. Willis) (formerly designated as Town Bluff).

Character and Conditions of Service:

Three-phase alternating current, delivered at approximately 60 hertz, at the nominal voltage and point of delivery, and in such quantities as provided by contract.

Monthly Rates:

SRMPA shall compensate Southwestern for Robert D. Willis Hydropower Power and Energy purchased by SRMPA, in the amount of \$67,965 per month (\$815,580 per year).

The preceding rate shall be applicable regardless of the quantity of Hydro Power and Energy available or delivered to SRMPA; provided, however, that if an "Uncontrollable Force" prevents utilization of both of the project's power generating units for an entire billing period, and if during such billing period water releases were being made which otherwise would have been used to generate Hydro Power and Energy, then Southwestern shall, upon request by SRMPA, suspended billing for subsequent billing periods, until such time as at least one of the project's generating units is again available.
