I. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FPCA

The Federal Post Card Application (FPCA) is the primary form for requesting registration and/or an absentee ballot from your local election official. **Read all instructions printed below and on the FPCA before completing and signing your application.** Circled letters correspond to the circled letters on the sample form on the preceding page.

- A Block 2.f: The last four digits of your social security number are required.
- Block 3.a through 3.e: Provide the complete street address of your Guam voting residence. A post office box is not sufficient. If your address includes a rural route, describe its location in Block 6. For example: "on Highway ______, 2 miles past Highway ______, across the street from the ______ gas station." This address must be within Guam and different from the one provided in Block 4.
- **⊙** Block 4.a: Print the complete address where you want your ballot sent usually your current mailing address. Your current mailing address must be different from the address you provided in Block 3.
- **D** Block 4.c: This form acts as a request for a mailed absentee ballot only. Guam does not allow you to receive or return the absentee ballot electronically. See Section II.D or III.D.
- Block 6: Submission of this form serves as a request to receive ballots for all Federal elections held through the next two regularly scheduled general elections. If you do not wish to receive ballots for that length of time, you may request a ballot for each election for Federal office held in the next election year OR a ballot for only the next scheduled election for Federal office by noting your choice here.
- **Block 7:** You must sign and date the FPCA. When signing, you are swearing or affirming that the information is true and correct.

II. UNIFORMED SERVICES

These procedures apply to persons who are U.S. citizens, residents of Guam and members of the Uniformed Services and their family members. Uniformed Services are defined as the U.S. Armed Forces, merchant marine, commissioned corps of the Public Health Service and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

A. Registering and Requesting an Absentee Ballot

You should send an FPCA to your local election official early every year and whenever you change your mailing

address (see Chapter Two). You may use a single FPCA to request ballots for all elections in a calendar year.

If you are an unregistered member of the Uniformed Services or merchant marine or a spouse or dependent of one of these, the Election Commission must receive your FPCA ballot request not later than 10 days before the election.

If you are a registered member of the Uniformed Services or merchant marine or a spouse or dependent of one of these, the Election Commission must receive your FPCA ballot request not less than 3 days before the election.

B. Casting Your Vote

Ballot Return Deadline: Voted ballot must arrive at the Election Commission **not later than 8 p.m. on election day.**

Local election officials mail ballots approximately 45 days before the election.

Due to its territorial status, Guam does not send representatives to the U.S. Senate or directly participate in the election of the President and Vice President of the U.S. At the Federal level, only a Delegate to the House of Representatives is elected.

If you have not received your Guam ballot in a timely manner, use the **Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot.** See instructions in Chapter Two.

C. Notary/Witness Requirements

FPCA: No notary or witness required.

Returning a Ballot: Must be sworn to before a commissioned officer, warrant officer, non-commissioned officer, or any other officer authorized to administer oaths.

D. Electronic Transmission of FPCAs and Ballots

Guam does not allow electronic transmission of the FPCA, the blank absentee ballot or the voted absentee ballot.

Guam can only receive absentee ballots by mail.

E. Bars to Registration and Voting

Persons imprisoned, confined to a mental institution, or found insane may not register or vote.

F. Cancellation of Registration

Registration is cancelled for failure to vote in two (2) consecutive general elections.

G. Action on Registration Requests

Notice of denial of registration is sent.

H. Action If Registration Is Denied

Persons denied registration may appeal to the Election Commission. Consult a legal assistance officer or civilian counsel. Upon denial of your voter registration application or absentee ballot request, Guam shall provide you with the reason(s) for the rejection.

III. CIVILIANS OUTSIDE U.S.

These procedures apply to persons who are U.S. citizens, residents of Guam and overseas electors. The term "overseas elector" means a U.S. citizen who resides outside the U.S. and (but for such residence) would be qualified to vote in Guam.

- Guam residents outside of Guam
- overseas electors

A. Registering and Requesting an Absentee Ballot

You should send an FPCA to your local election official early every year and whenever you change your mailing address (see Chapter Two). You may use a single FPCA to request ballots for all elections in a calendar year.

If you are an unregistered citizen in one of the above categories, the Election Commission must receive your FPCA ballot request not later than 10 days before the election.

If you are a registered citizen in one of the above categories, the Election Commission must receive your FPCA ballot request not less than 3 days before the election.

B. Casting Your Vote

Ballot Return Deadline: Voted ballot must arrive at the Election Commission not later than 8 p.m. on election day.

Local election officials mail ballots approximately 45 days before the election.

Due to its territorial status, Guam does not send representatives to the U.S. Senate or directly participate in the election of the President and Vice President of the U.S. At the Federal level, only a Delegate to the House of Representatives is elected.

If you have not received your Guam ballot in a timely manner, use the **Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot.** See instructions in Chapter Two.

C. Notary/Witness Requirements

FPCA: No notary or witness required.

Returning a Ballot: Must be sworn to before a commissioned officer, warrant officer, non-commissioned officer, or any other officer authorized to administer oaths.

D. Electronic Transmission of FPCAs and Ballots

Guam does not allow electronic transmission of the FPCA, the blank absentee ballot or the voted absentee ballot.

E. Bars to Registration and Voting

H. Action If Registration Is Denied

Persons denied registration may appeal to the Election Commission. Consult a legal assistance officer or civilian counsel. Upon denial of your voter registration application or absentee ballot request, Guam shall provide you with the reason(s) for the rejection.
