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

Why Register?

- Standards are mandatory for users, owners and operators of bulk power system
 - Compliance Monitoring and Enforcement
- Registration provides communications conduit for NERC <-> Region <-> Entity
 - Standards Alerts
- Registration will be voluntary or involuntary



Who Needs to Register?

- Users, owners and operators of the bulk power system that meet the criteria outlined in the NERC Standards and Functional Model including:
 - Generation Owners
 - Generation Operators
- At this time, there are no thresholds specified for size, operational hours or voltage interconnection
 - Regional Compliance Managers have submitted suggested registration thresholds to NERC

Generator Owner [GO] versus Generator Operator [GOP]

Generator Owner

- Attributes [Off-Line Activities]
 - Certify ratings for modeling
 - Fund maintenance requirements
 - Site new facilities
 - Fund and report periodic testing

Generation Operator

- Attributes [On-line or Real-time Activities]
 - Communicate real-time values
 - Provide daily generation plans
 - Report status of equipment



Generator Owner & Generator Operator

- Most generating facilities are subject to the recent Cyber Security standards
- Increased paperwork, recordkeeping and reporting leading to increased personnel requirements

What Happens In 2006 After Registration?

- Information is shared with NERC
 - Presently this information is considered confidential
- Entity is added to appropriate information distribution lists
 - Standards Announcements
 - Meeting Announcements
 - Compliance Program Announcements
- In 2006, no change in Region <-> Entity relationship



2007 and Beyond

- Expectation is that compliance to standards will be mandatory
- Increased testing of equipment will be required
- Increased documentation of test results and increased reporting requirements
- Participation in annual compliance program will be mandatory



2007 and Beyond

- Enforcement will include financial penalties
- <u>All</u> entities will have due process protections of Region, NERC and FERC
- Membership in Regional Entity is not mandatory
