

Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington, PA-NJ-DE-MD

- In the first half of 2007, the Philadelphia-Camden-Wilmington metropolitan area was the 13th largest export market in the U.S., with sales totaling \$9.1 billion.
- Canada was the leading export destination for Philadelphia's exports of goods in the first half of 2007. Other leading destinations were the United Kingdom and Mexico.
- In the first half of 2007, Philadelphia benefited from existing free trade agreements, exporting \$3.2 billion to Canada and Mexico and \$101 million to the Central America and the Dominican Republic region.
- Thirty-five percent of Philadelphia's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
- Chemicals were the top Philadelphia export category for the first half of 2007, accounting for \$3.3 billion, or 36 percent, of exported goods.
- Other top exports were computer and electronic products (\$1.1 billion, 12 percent); transportation equipment (\$630 million, 7 percent); and machinery, except electrical (\$537 million, 6 percent).
