

Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale, AZ

- In the first half of 2007, the Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale, AZ metropolitan area was the 18th largest export market in the U.S., with merchandise sales totaling \$6.7 billion.
- The Phoenix metropolitan area accounted for 75 percent of Arizona's merchandise exports in the first half of 2007.
- Canada was one of the leading export destinations for Phoenix's exports of goods in the first half of 2007. Other leading destinations were Mexico and China.
- In the first half of 2007, Phoenix benefited from existing free trade agreements, exporting \$1.3 billion to the NAFTA region.
- Nineteen percent of Phoenix's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
- Computer and electronic products was the top Phoenix export category for the first half of 2007, accounting for \$3.1 billion of exported goods, or 46 percent, of the metropolitan area total.
- Other top exports were transportation equipment (\$1.5 billion, 23 percent); electrical equipment, appliances, and parts (\$487 million, 7 percent); and machinery, except electrical (\$385 million, 6 percent).
