Survey Methodology

- 1. A computer printout of each States public libraries was sent to the Chief Officers of the respective State Library Agencies for updating by personnel of the State Library Agencies.
- 2. The changes indicated on the printouts were keyed onto tapes/disks.
- 3. Deletions and additions were transcribed to a form suitable to be keyed from, and were keyed to tapes/disks.
- 4. The keyed data was printed and visually verified.
- 5. Corrections to detected keying errors were keyed, placed on tapes/disks, printed and reviewed for accuracy.
- 6. The additions, changes and deletions were applied to the Universe from the previous survey.
- 7. The SMSA's and the Central City Place Description recode (CICD) were updated/developed using (a) the tape version of the fourth update of the FIPS Publication 55 (Codes for Named Populated Places, Primary County Divisions and other Locational Entities of the U.S.) and (b) a list from the <u>Statistical Reporter</u> entitled "Titles and Definitions of the Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas".

8. The updated 1981 file was compared to the 1977 Public Library Universe and the differences found in the SMSA's and CICD were evaluated and adjusted as required.
