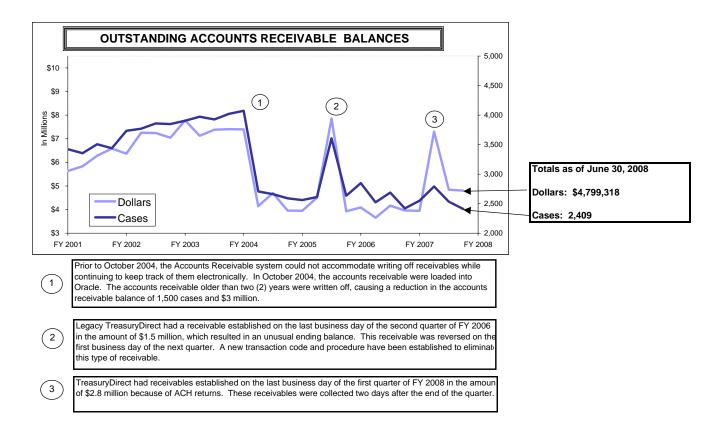

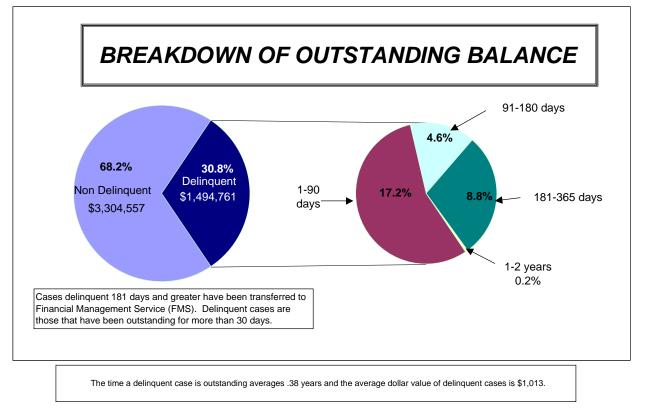

### Accounts Receivable Analysis

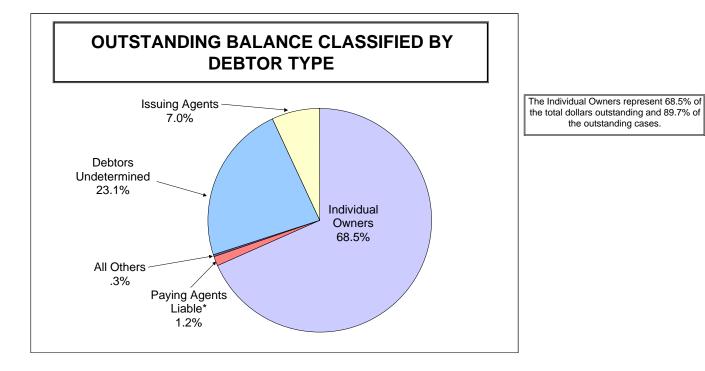

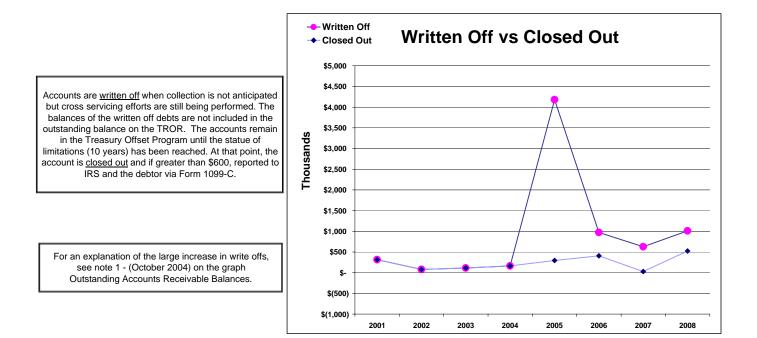




### Bureau of the Public Debt Accounts Receivable Analysis

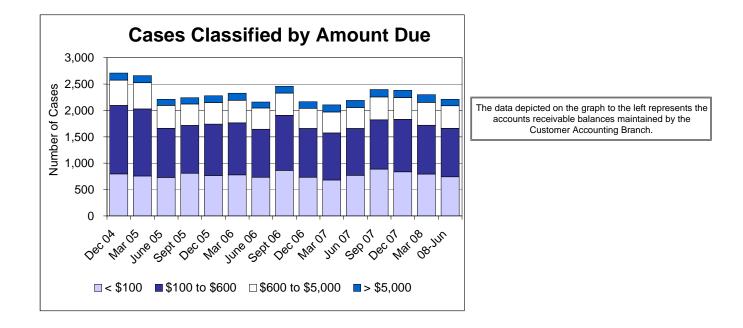

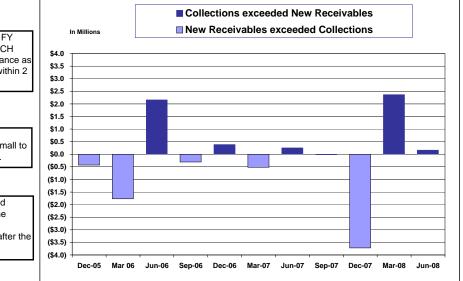

## **Collections vs New Receivables**



The majority of the increase during the 3rd Quarter of FY 2006 is attributable to Legacy Treasury Direct Debit ACH transactions. Even though there is a large ending balance as of 2nd Quarter, these cases are normally completed within 2 business days.

Collections exceeded New Receivables during the 4th Quarter of FY 2007. The amount (\$24,262) was too small to display when compared to the previous eight quarters.

During the 1st Quarter of FY 2008, TreasuryDirect had receivables established on the last business day of the quarter in the amount of \$2.8 million because of ACH returns. These receivables were collected two days after the end of the quarter.
