Illinois Letter Carrier Arrested and Removed for Selling Marijuana from LLV

Working jointly with the Illinois Police Department, U.S. Postal Service Office of Inspector General (USPS OIG) Special Agents arrested a Letter Carrier for state narcotics violations after he was observed selling marijuana from his postal vehicle while on duty. Subsequent to his arrest, a search warrant was served at the letter carrier's residence where agents seized drug paraphernalia and several bundles of Bulk Business Mail, which had not been delivered to customers on his route. The letter carrier was issued a Letter of Removal from the Postal Service, effective February 16.
