SUBJECT: Department of Energy (DOE) FY 2008 and FY 2009 Small

Business Subcontracting Goals

DOE has agreed to the following small business subcontracting goals, as proposed by the Small Business Administration (SBA), for Fiscal Years (FY) 2008 and 2009:

| Small business concerns | 46.4% |
|--|-------|
| Small disadvantaged business concerns | 5.0% |
| Women-owned small business concern | 5.0% |
| HUB-Zone small business concerns | 3.0% |
| Service-disabled veteran-owned small business concerns | 3.0% |

(Note: The overall small business subcontracting goal has increased from the previous 41.3% goal from FY 2007 to 46.4%. The goals for the other categories are consistent with the Government-wide goals.)

Please ensure that Contracting Officers and Small Business Program Managers are aware of these new Departmental goals when they negotiate subcontracting plans with their prime contractors.

The Department is currently finalizing the prime contract goals and we will disseminate those to you as soon as they are final.
