## FedBizOpps "Awarded" Data

The <u>FedBizOpps</u> (formerly the Commerce Business Daily) lists federal government procurement opportunities that are valued at over \$25,000. Previously, customers could just search, monitor and retrieve opportunities solicited by the federal contracting community. Now, the date, value and the company awarded the contract are viewable as well!
