



Program Manager/Instructor to the *Inspector General Criminal Investigator Academy*

The Inspector General Criminal Investigator Academy (IGCIA) is seeking nominations from employees of PCIE and ECIE member organizations for a detail opportunity to the position of Program Manager/Instructor, IG CIA, Glynco, Georgia. The IG CIA's mission is to train those who protect our nation's taxpayers from fraud, waste and abuse.

Qualified candidates will be enthusiastic, organized and experienced criminal investigators (GS-1811-12/13) with subject matter expertise in OIG investigations such as contract fraud, grant fraud, loan fraud and/or program fraud. An individual with knowledge of instructional design and experience in law enforcement training is preferred. Duties of the position include curriculum development, classroom instruction and program coordination. Occasional travel will be required.

The detailee will report to the Executive Director, IG CIA. The official duty station is Glynco, GA. The detail will be for an initial period of three years and may be extended in one-year increments at the discretion of the Accountable Inspector General and the employing OIG, with the concurrence of the Executive Director of the IG CIA. While assigned as Program Manager/Instructor, the detailee remains on the rolls of the employing OIG and returns to duty at that organization at the end of the detail.

The employing OIG will be reimbursed for the detailee's salary costs from the Academy's revolving fund.

It is critical to have quality personnel representing the OIG community at the IG CIA and FLETC. This detailee will be managing training programs that enable OIG investigators to effectively accomplish their missions. If you have an interested, qualified candidate, this detail assignment represents an excellent opportunity for your agency to make a contribution to the entire OIG community. I also believe the return on your agency's investment will be significant, as this is an extraordinary developmental assignment. I encourage you to give this memorandum the widest possible distribution in your organization, and if an outstanding employee expresses an interest in being considered, that you encourage and support his or her application.
