POSSIBLE CREATION OF A NEW HEADING FOR BIODEGRADABLE PLASTICS AND ARTICLES THEREOF

I. BACKGROUND

- 1. At its 13th Session (December 1997), the Scientific Sub-Committee continued its examination of a proposal by Japan for the creation of a new heading for biodegradable plastics and articles thereof.
- 2. The Japanese Delegate took the view that separate identification of biodegradable plastics in the HS was important because of environmental concerns and the potential growth in the trade of these products. However, some delegates had doubts as to the need for separate identification of these products, in the light of increasing tendencies towards plastics recycling. There were also differing views as to how and where to locate any new categories for these products in the HS structure.
- 3. Following the discussion, the Sub-Committee decided to re-examine this matter at its next session. The Japanese Administration was asked to provide further information in this regard, in particular, the basis for selecting biodegradable plastics for separate

identification, criteria for distinguishing them from other plastics and the uses of these products. Other administrations were also invited to submit comments in this regard.

II. SUBMISSION FROM THE JAPANESE ADMINISTRATION

4. On 21 December 1998, the Secretariat received a note from the Japanese Administration, including a table of information concerning the biodegradability, uses and suggested HS classifications of some of the biodegradable products in question. This table is reproduced in the Annex to this document.

III. CONCLUSION

5. The Sub-Committee is invited to examine the information appearing in the annex and to give its views concerning whether and how to identify these products separately in the Harmonized System.
