The American Red Cross offers many services, to include:

Reporting & Communication: Verification of emergencies in the United States is provided to commanders to determine leave status. A family member can also request verification of a problem when he/she is unable to contact family at home or when more details are needed. This service is provided for emergencies 24 hours daily, 365 days a year.

Health & Safety Courses: Monthly CPR and First Aid courses are offered to the public. Courses in parenthood preparation, parenting skills, water safety, and baby-sitting are available on an as-needed basis. There is normally a small fee for course materials prior to enrolling in any of these courses.

<u>Volunteer Service</u>: Many community organizations use volunteers to help provide a better service to the Bamberg Military Community. Volunteers are offered job experience, the opportunity to learn new skills, and a chance to help out in our community. Leadership positions are also available for those who are well organized and work well with others. Volunteer orientations are held every month for new volunteers.

***Please ensure that in the event of an emergency, your family back home knows how to reach you. Both the sponsor's and the spouse's family should know the soldier's complete name, rank, social security number, and unit address. This information should be taken to the Red Cross office nearest your family so those messages can be sent to verify any emergencies. We have

special forms at the Red Cross office that you can use to send this information to your families. Take the time to do this; you never know when an emergency will occur.

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL PROGRAMS (I&R):

This program is part of the Relocation Assistance Program, provides information regarding military community resources and referral to appropriate agencies. Whenever you have a question about an ACS program, or need post information make our office your first stop.

ARMY FAMILY TEAM BUILDING (AFTB)

AFTB offers training for the unique challenges and opportunities that comes with being married to a soldier or an Army Civilian Employee. Workshops and seminars give family members the tools they need to take charge of their lives, manage military life's pressures, seize opportunities, and focus on the future. **Army 101** is designed to get you off on the right foot as an Army spouse here in Europe. **Army 102**

takes a deeper look at Army life. Additional workshops on leadership, management, coping with crises and other life skills are offered each month. Interested in volunteering for AFTB? **Instructor Training** is offered in March and October.

ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF (AER):

The primary mission of AER is to provide emergency financial assistance to soldiers and their family members. Assistance is provided as an interest-free loan, a grant, or a combination loan/grant, whichever is most appropriate based upon the applicant's financial situation. A secondary type of assistance is AER's Educational Assistance Program for spouses and children of active duty soldiers.

FINANCIAL READINESS PROGRAM

The Financial Readiness Program's services include basic financial education, budget development, financial counseling, debt reduction support, consumer advocacy, and information on financial issues as well as support to unit commanders. Also, there are check-writing classes available every month. Sign up at ACS.

PEOPLE ENCOURAGING PEOPLE (PEP)

PEP offers a fun, five-day monthly welcome program, which includes the opportunity to learn about the Bamberg community, Warner Barracks resources and services, as well as German customs, culture, and languages. Free limited childcare is available on first come, first served basis.

FAMILY ADVOCACY PROGRAM (FAP):

The Family Advocacy Program has training and classes to prevent, identify, assess, and treat incidents of spouse and child abuse. Programs include: (continued on next page)

STRESS MANAGEMENT

This program offers fun, hands-on and interactive workshops. Topics include Stress Management,

Family Violence, Conflict Resolution, Communication, and Time Management. Limited free childcare is available.

EMERGENCY PLACEMENT CARE (FOSTER CARE PROGRAM)

The Emergency Placement Care Program offers temporary, alternative living arrangements for children whose parents become hospitalized, abused, or in some other way unable to care for their children. Upon termination of a child's placement in the foster home, follow-up services are provided to both the foster family and the child's natural family to minimize disruption and optimize the experience for all participants.

EXCEPTIONAL FAMILY MEMBER PROGRAM MANAGER (EFMP)

The EFMP is a mandatory enrollment program that works with other military and civilian agencies to provide and coordinate community support, educational, housing, personnel and medical services to families with special needs. Who is an exceptional family member? Any family member with physical, emotional, developmental or intellectual needs that requires special treatment, therapy, education or counseling is an EFM. The EFMP staff educates, assists, advocates, and coordinates soldiers, civilians and family members on EFMP issues/concerns.

RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM:

Here to assist with your relocation needs. This office has comprehensive information files on military

Installations worldwide and SITES (Standard Installations Topic Exchange Service), which consists of printed topics of information about installations. Also offered are sponsorship training, PCS and ETS orientation briefings, pre-deployment briefings, Bicultural Program, and Family Member Employment Assistance program.

LOAN CLOSET:

This program offers basic kitchen items on a 60-day loan agreement to all incoming and outgoing personnel. We offer such items as transformers, pots and pans, plates, cooking utensils, silverware, glasses, coffee makers, irons, toasters, playpens, high chairs, booster seats, cars seats, etc.

The APO provides domestic, international, and military (MPS) postal services. These services include, but are not limited to; insured, registered, delivery confirmation, certified, and return receipt mail. All current postage stamps are available as well as U.S. Postal Money Orders.

Wrapping paper, tape, pens and scissors are available in the lobby for wrapping your parcels and are provided as a courtesy of the USAG Commander.

Appointments are available on a limited basis prior to regular lobby hours regardless of how many parcels you have to mail. Simply ask at the window or call the numbers listed above for an appointment.

Valid I.D. cards must be shown and services are limited to those postal patrons that are stationed or live in USAEUR and have a valid USAEUR APO return address.

A few of the services available:

FIRST CLASS/PRIORITY MAIL: These classes are usually the quickest and most economical way to send your letters and packages. Priority packages may not exceed 70 lbs. and 100" in length and girth combined. May take 7 to 10 days. Priority being the fastest of the two services.

EXPRESS MAIL: Takes two or three days depending on destination and does not count the day of mailing. Contents automatically insured up to \$100 for loss or damage. More insurance may be purchased. Same size and weight limitations as priority mail apply.

SPACE AVAILABLE MAIL (SAM): Packages are airlifted to New York on a space available basis then may be trucked or sent surface to destination. Packages may not exceed 70lbs and 130" length and girth combined (packages over 100" up to the limit of 130" are subject to a substantial surcharge!).

MILITARY POSTAL SERVICE (MPS) MAIL: All packages and letters destined for other intra-theater APO addresses and not weighing more than 70lbs or exceed 100" in length and girth may be sent free of charge (with no services, i.e. insurance, registered, certified).

As with all classes of mail, restrictions may apply. We are sorry but we are unable to provide postage price cost estimates over the phone. The only mail guaranteed to arrive at a certain time is express (entry into U.S. Customs negates the guarantee). This express guarantee provides only a cash refund for the postage, not for losses occurred due to the lateness of the materials contained in the express mail.
