# Occupational Health 2015 Vision: "A Healthier Workforce"

- Elimination of hazardous occupational exposures in NASA workplace environments
- Creation of superior preventive health programs aimed at reducing all other non-occupational risk factors



Occupational Health Organizational Structure that includes:

- Full integration of philosophies
- Center representation with direct access to Senior Management
- Greater Center budget influence
- Recognition appropriate to value of the function



Occupational Health Provider Workforce that includes:

- Competent, responsive team with access to training
- Full comprehension of the OCHMO ITA for health and medical requirements and matters
- Adequate representation of all disciplines
- Wellness culture



#### Occupational Health Programs that will:

- Serve as international benchmark
- Manage data via electronic health records (EHR)
  - Capture health maintenance and exposure data for analysis and trending
  - Develop longitudinal health assessment capability

- Institute fully functional Medical QA Program
- Standardization
- Full EHR System deployment
- Evaluate effectiveness of implementation of Institute of Medicine (IOM) report findings
- Continual update of OH policies
