The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) was enacted to help government decision makers navigate the issues involved in any activity significantly affecting the environment. Using the NEPA process, leaders gain the knowledge to unlock long-term sustainability to support Soldier training and to protect the environment. In an effort to promote communication of lessons learned and best practices, the U.S. Army Environmental Command (USAEC) has developed a listserv primarily for the Army NEPA community. The listserv brings together NEPA practitioners from across the Army to share advice, expertise and resources, as well as the latest in case law and applications related to the NEPA process.

MEMBERSHIP

This service is open to all Department of Defense employees. All federal agency (civilian and military) and non-federal personnel are eligible to participate. The listserv is considered a federal activity; therefore, non-federal applicants require a federal agency point of contact (POC) to sponsor membership. Please discuss sponsorship with your potential federal point of contact prior to joining.

HOW TO JOIN THE NEPA LISTSERV?

- 2 Complete the "Apply for Membership" form that includes:
 - First Name
 - Last Name
 - Organization
 - E-mail address
 - Phone number
 - Agency (federal or non-federal). If non-federal, indicate federal sponsor POC name and e-mail address.
- 3 Confirmation will be sent to your e-mail address once membership is approved.
