Referred to as Army NEPA Online, the repository acts as a stand-alone library and allows the Army, other federal agencies and federally sponsored personnel access to NEPA-related information contained within the site.

NEPA Online contains Environmental Assessments (EAs), Findings of No Significant Impact (FNSI), Environmental Impact Statements (EISs), Records of Decision (RODs), and other NEPA program-related documents. A tutorial, which can be accessed through the Army Environmental Reporting Online (AERO) portal,

has been developed to assist users navigating through the repository.

The system allows users to browse or search the repository using several different methods including metadata, advanced, and full text searches. It also



allows users to download documents directly to their workstations, as well as upload documents for inclusion in the repository. Once a document of interest has been located, it may be saved to a local or network computer and can be used as a reference document.

NEPA Online is password protected and accessible through Army Knowledge Online (AKO) and AERO. To become an online user contact the USAEC Help Desk and provide your name, AKO user name, AKO e-mail address, phone number and mailing address.
