



STANDARDIZED UXO DEMONSTRATION SITES

STANDARDIZED TARGET REPOSITORY



The Standardized Target Repository facilitates UXO technology testing and performance evaluation.

The Standardized UXO Technology Demonstration Sites Program maintains a standardized target repository to provide the UXO community with standardized and nonstandard targets for UXO technology testing and performance evaluation. The program has over 400 items currently on loan to the UXO research and development community.

INVENTORY

The repository includes mortars, projectiles, rockets and submunitions from 20 mm to 155 mm in size. Other targets include the following nonstandard items:

- Tail fins
- Corroded munitions
- Range clutter
- Fuzes
- 8 lb and 12 lb steel spheres
- 30 cm and 60 cm steel discs
- 15 cm or 30 cm copper wire loops

Standardized metallic spheres will soon be available for loan. All repository items are inert.

DATA COLLECTION

Borrowers are required to provide the program with the raw data collected during testing with the repository items. Data sharing is on a valid need basis without the release of proprietary information.

REPOSITORY ACCESS

Standardized Target Repository inventory items are available to members of the UXO community with a validated need. Borrowers may check out the items for up to one year. Users are required to provide raw data collected from the items to the Standardized UXO Technology Demonstration Sites Program. Data will be shared with the UXO community based on a demonstrated need.

To request a loan of items from the Standardized Target Repository, borrowers must submit an application for the items. The application is available at www.uxotestsites.org. Allow a lead-time of four to six weeks.

Final approval rests with the Standardized UXO Technology Demonstration Sites program manager.
