SUMMER HOUSING 2008

A. WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

During the summer of 2008, summer housing for Hood College students will be <u>limited</u>. All students will be housed based on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority will be given to international students, students working on-campus and/or taking classes, or students doing internships in the area. Summer Research Institute students are guaranteed housing <u>but must apply by the deadlines stated below</u>.

Graduating seniors and those students not returning to campus in the fall will be housed after <u>all</u> current and returning-to-residence students.

B. APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please fill out the attached application and return it to the Residence Life Office by Monday, April 18, 2008. If you are interested in rooming with a specific person, please indicate so on your application. Both students must request one another in order for the assignment to be made. Singles are available and will be given out based on lottery number/priority order. If you wish to be considered for one of the singles, please indicate so on your application.

The Crystal Park apartments (20 spaces) will also be available during the summer housing period. Current apartment residents have priority for the apartments. All apartments are 4 person, 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom apartments. Students living in the apartments for the summer will be billed at the double room rate. All utilities, with the exception of phone service, are included in the summer housing rates for apartments. Students can choose to purchase phone service through Verizon and be reimbursed by the College (please see Residence Life Office for reimbursement rates).

Information about your room and roommate assignment will be sent out by April 21, 2008.

C. <u>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</u>

- 1. From May 19 June 2, summer housing will be in Smith Hall. On June 6, 2008, summer housing residents will be moved to Shriner Hall, where they will remain for the duration of the summer.
- 2. Students who reside in summer housing will be allowed to move into their fall residence halls beginning at 8:00 a.m. Saturday, August 9, 2008. Students not returning to Hood College housing for the fall 2008 semester must be out of their summer rooms 12:00 noon on Saturday, August 9, 2008. Please note that we will not be able to make any exceptions to these dates due to Housekeeping's need to get the halls ready for the fall semester. Students who are leaving summer housing before August 9 but who are returning to campus for the fall will have to put their belongings in storage if they will be residing in a different room in the fall.
- 3. The cost of summer housing will be \$160 per week for a space in a double room and \$185 for a single. These fees do not include meals. Please make arrangements to pay your bill prior to your arrival, as our accounting office is not open on the weekends. Those who have not paid their bill by their move in date will not be permitted access to the residence hall.

- 4. A summer housing contract (which will be sent to the student when his/her application is accepted) must also be signed to secure a space for the summer. Canceling the contract before the first payment is made will result in a cancellation charge equal to one week's rent. Once a contract has been signed and a student has moved in, students are responsible for payment of the full amount for the period that the contract addresses. No refunds will be made. Adjustments will be considered at the discretion of the Director of Residence Life. If the contract is not returned by May 5, 2008, the student may forfeit his/her summer housing space.
- 5. Students in summer housing will abide by the Code of Student Conduct and are expected to live cooperatively with others in residence. Students who violate the Code will have their housing revoked and will not be entitled to a refund.
- 6. Regular overnight guests **are not permitted** in residence during the summer housing period. Students will be allowed one guest per week who may stay for no more than two days and nights. **Guests must be registered with the Residence Life Office**.
- 7. Per new Code of Student Conduct guidelines, <u>Hood College residence halls are dry during the summer sessions</u>. This means that <u>no alcoholic beverages</u> (open or unopened containers) are permitted in the residence halls from the time the halls close in May until the time classes begin on August 25, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. Students who violate this policy will be evicted from summer housing.

D. HOW DO I APPLY?

Applications will be approved on a first-come, first-served basis, so apply early!
