Commander René Hernández has been a Research Physiologist in the United States Navy for the past 16 years, after earning a Ph.D. in Neuroscience, and has become an expert in hyperbaric neurophysiology. She has published papers in the areas of hyperbaric oxygen toxicity and calcium channel behavior in response to ionizing radiation. CDR Hernández made significant contributions to the health and fitness of Navy personnel by researching, writing and implementing the Navy Instruction (OPNAVINST 6110.1E) on physical fitness testing.
