

COL Joseph Kolb, MD, USA

Colonel Joseph Kolb is a 1990 Doctor of Medicine graduate of the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences. He completed his general surgery residency in 1995 at Fitzsimons Army Medical Center, Colorado, followed by a plastic surgery residency at the University of Texas Health Science Center, San Antonio, which he completed in 2000. Dr. Kolb is a 1982 graduate of the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. Prior to coming to USU, he served on active duty as an Army infantry officer, assigned to the 3rd Battalion, 327th Infantry of the 101st Airborne Division, based in Ft. Campbell, Kentucky. As Chief, Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, Dr. Kolb has been actively involved in the care of war wounded from both Afghanistan and Iraq. Dr. Kolb also deployed to Afghanistan as part of Operation Enduring Freedom. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Plastic Surgery and the American Board of Surgery. In 2000, he served as President of the Society of Military Plastic Surgeons.
