Dr. Eleanor S. “Lee” Metcalf is the Associate Dean for Graduate Education at USU and Professor of Microbiology and Immunology, and Molecular and Cell Biology. She earned her A.B. degree in Chemistry from Ohio Wesleyan University, followed by an M.S. degree in Microbiology from the University of Michigan. In 1976, she completed her Ph.D. in Immunology at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. She later earned a Master of Social Work degree from Catholic University of America. Dr. Metcalf came to USU in 1977 as an assistant professor of microbiology. From 1999-2006, she served as director of USU’s Emerging Infectious Diseases graduate program. She was named Associate Dean for Graduate Education in 2006.
