## The 2009 Bay Area Clean Air Plan will:

- Update the Bay Area 2005 Ozone Strategy in accordance with the requirements of the California Clean Air Act to implement "all feasible measures" to reduce ozone
- Consider impacts of ground-level ozone control measures on particulate matter, air toxics, and greenhouse gases in a single integrated plan
- Review progress in improving air quality in recent years
- Establish emission control measures to be adopted or implemented in the 2009-2012 timeframe

- Solicit your ideas and suggestions for the Plan
